-the colt “shudders his coat” -speaker’s feeling about colt -rhyme

“I’m Nobody”

-What does the speaker value? -simile/metaphor

“My Father Is a Simple Man”

-What is the poem about? -Free verse -speaker’s feeling about his father

“Mama Is a Sunrise”

-Describe the mama -simile/metaphor

“The Blind Men and the Elephant”

-conflict in the poem -simile/metaphor -T/F about events in the poem

“Jabberwocky”

-nonsense words -alliteration -onomatopoeia

“Madam and the Rent Man”

-ironic ending -tone *-the effects of dialogue*

“Annabel Lee”

-recall details -repetition -tone

“maggie and milly and molly and may”

-setting -describe the girls -nonstandard English

“The Highwayman”

-detail from the poem -narrative poem -alliteration
