POETRY

Definitions:

- Poetry: Literature that uses rhythm, rhyme, sound or structure to express something in an artistic way. Provokes strong emotions/images.
 - Organization includes lines and stanzas
- **Prose:** Literature that is NOT poetry. EX: Essays, short stories, novels plays
 - Organization includes sentences and paragraphs
- Figurative Language: Language used for descriptive effect, often to imply ideas indirectly.
- Metaphor: A comparison of two unlike things by saying that one thing is a <u>dissimilar</u> object or thing
 - **EX**: The snow was a blanket that covered the entire field
- Simile: A comparison of two <u>unlike</u> things using like or as.
 - **EX:** His words were like surgery, they cut, but also made me feel better.
- Hyperbole: An exaggeration that cannot possibly be true and is not meant to be taken literally.
 - **EX:** When Albert argued with his sister it was like a million paper cuts.
- Personification: Giving Human characteristics to nonhuman things.
 - EX: The distant lights called to me guiding me home.
