





<u>Modified Schedule</u> student takes less than seven (7) courses. Only seniors are permitted to request a modified schedule provided they have met all graduation requirements (to include courses currently requested).

Requests must be made prior to May 27, 2022 and forms must be signed. Forms will NOT be accepted after this date.

A Blended Schedule a mix of on campus courses and courses taken virtually through SJVS or FLVS. This option is open to all students.

Students are NOT permitted to take more than three (3) courses virtually- Students must still be registered for seven courses, unless a senior who will meet all graduation requirements. S
