
## Face to Face


#### CHOICE PROJECTS

If you have any questions or need any clarification on an assignment, please let me know! Don't be afraid to "mess up" on something new. If you do, share it any way!




# What if I need extra help?

### Assessments

- We have formative and summative assessments.

### Tips for Success

- Set a daily schedule for your student for digital days (when to get up, when to start working, how much time to allocate per each class on the schedule, etc.). Allow at least one hour per class.
