Here is the VPK plan through April 20th to help navigate through this distance learning experience.

Suggested Daily Schedule

- Structured Learning Complete 1 lesson sheet per day (front and back / provided)
- Letter and Letter Sound Recognition Choose 1 activity below perday
- Numbers/Colors/Shapes Choose 1 activity below per day
- Oral Language and Vocabulary Choose 1 activity below per day
- Social/Emotional Learning Choose 1 activity below per day

Letter and Letter Sound Recognition

- Use pipe cleaners to form letters by bending them. *
- Play <u>I Spy</u> using letters and sounds while reading a book. Say "I spy something that starts with the letter B. Remember what sound a B makes? Bbb, Bbb, can you guess what I'm looking at?"
- Use chalk to write letters in each square of a sidewalk hopscotch grid. Say the name of each letter and something that starts with that letter sound as hopping from square to square.
- Write your child's name on a piece of construction paper in large letters. Glue on yarn, beans or glitter.
 Be sure to start with and uppercase letter and write the rest in lower case letters. *
- Create letters using fun things such as playdough, pretzels or sticks. Talk about the sound they make.

Numbers/Colors/Shapes

- Count objects with children (e.g., their fingers, toes, buttons on their shirt, trees in the yard) and point
 out numerals (written) in the world around them (e.g., in books, magazines, labels)
- During cooking activities, discuss order that ingredients are added (e.g., "First, ... Second,...)
- Show your child how to use string or yarn to "measure" parts of their hody. Cut the string and hold it out: How long is it? Can they compare it to other body parts? *
- Have a "yellow" day. Wear something yellow. Find yellow things in your home. Eat yellow foods.
- Have your child find and draw items in the yard that are shaped like triangle. *

Oral language and Vocabulary

Add new words by using a synonym for a commonly used word (e.g., motor = engine, help = assist, fat
 stout)

- Describe children's actions with varied descriptive words (e.g., Instead of saying "Run to the mailbox." say "Dash to the large, green mailbox.")
- Provide and read to children a variety of concept-related books (e.g., farm animals, vegetables, the body, fiction and nonfiction)
- Mix up a sentence like, "Your strawberry is green. My coffee is crunchy," or "This ice cream is hot." Give your child a chance to correct you and show how much he/she knows beforehe/she takes a turn mixing things up. *
- Use a teddy bear to have your child position it around the room making sure to use words like "in, out, under, on, beside, in front of" etc. *


Social/Emotional Learning

- Talk to your child about feelings. Let your child know it is ok for them to have different feelings (ex. Happy, sad, mad and scared)
- Help your child learn how to relax and calm him/herself. Teach helicopter Stretches. Stretch your arms to each side to make the blades. Gently twist side to side as far as you can. Slowly inhale and exhale with each twist. *
- Establish family rituals where everybody spends time together. Board games and bedtime stories are great!
- Give your child "real" jobs in the house and work together. Completing a task together with your child will show them the value of working cooperatively with others.
- Make a face the expresses a feeling & ask your child to make a face that shows the opposite feeling.*

Note: The Value of Play:


- Children learn through play.
 - ➤ Cognitive skills like math and problem solving in a pretent grocery store
 - Physical abilities like balancing blocks and running and jumping outside
 - New vocabulary like the words they need to play with toy dinosaurs
 - Social skills like playing together in a pretend car wash
 - ➤ Literacy skills like creating a menu for a pretend restaurant
 - > Creative Art skills like creating art for local nursing home residents
- Play is healthy and reduces stress.
- Play is a child's context for learning.






