## Delmar High School recognizes State FFA honorees

**Delmar, DE, Monday, April 15th:** Delmar Senior High School students involved in FFA (formerly known as the Future Farmers of America) recently attended the organization's state competition. This convention, held annually in March (the month the association was founded in 1930), gives students the opportunity to participate in Career Development Events (CDEs), the Delegate Process, and serve as members of the State Officer Nominating Committee which makes decisions that will affect the future of the association. The students also attend workshops with keynote speakers that further develop premier leadership, personal growth and career success.

Evan Davis and Hannah Young were selected as 2013-2014 Sussex County FFA representatives, a first ever accomplishment for the Delmar Senior High School.
