STAFFING

Lincoln Park Primary is fully staffed.
14 teachers returned from 2015-2016.
2 teachers are new to Lincoln Park this year.
Lincoln Park has 1 first year teacher.
No teachers were hired from recruiting trips or at the Teacher Fair.

Warrington Elementary is fully staffed.
17 teachers returned from 2015-2016.
13 teachers are new to Warrington this year.
Warrington has 5 first year teachers.
1 teacher was hired from recruiting trips or at the Teacher Fair.

Oakcrest Elementary is fully staffed.
35 teachers returned from 2015-2016.
10 teachers are new to Oakcrest this year.
Oakcrest has 4 first year teachers.
8 teachers were hired from recruiting trips or at the Teacher Fair.

Montclair Elementary is not fully staffed.
Position advertised for 1st Grade.
18 teachers returned from 2015-2016.
11 teachers are new to Montclair this year.
Montclair has 3 first year teachers.
8 teachers were hired from recruiting trips or at the Teacher Fair.

C. A. Weis Elementary is not fully staffed.
Positions advertised for 2nd Grade and Reading Intervention Teacher.
23 teachers returned from 2015-2016.
18 teachers are new to Weis this year.
Weis has 8 first year teachers.
6 teachers were hired from recruiting trips or at the Teacher Fair.

PROGRESS MONITORING FOR “D” AND “F” SCHOOLS

BEHAVIOR

- Extra staff was provided by the Student Services Department and ESE Department during the first week of school.
- All of the Priority Schools have teams certified in the Safety-Care™ Behavioral Safety Program, which is replacing the CPI training.
- Oakcrest and Montclair have mental health counselors provided by the Children’s Home Society. Warrington has a Lakeview overlay counselor assigned to the school 4 days per week. Weis has mental health services offered through the Community School.

ELA SPECIFIC CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT

- A Reading Intervention Teacher has been assigned to each Priority School to work with small groups of students.
- Implementation of SRA Reading Mastery Signature and/or Corrective Reading during the extended hour supported by Lisa Entekin, Elementary ELA TSA.
- Professional Development for standards-based planning to include small group instruction supported by Jodi Broussard, Elementary ELA TSA.
- Professional Development and implementation of the Comprehension Instructional Sequence (CIS) Teaching Model supported by Lisa Marsh, Elementary ELA Specialist.
- Classroom walkthroughs with the Elementary ELA Specialist and school administration.
- Data analysis and instructional adjustments based on the data supported by Elementary ELA Specialist and TSAs.

MATHEMATICS SPECIFIC CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT

- Utilize Everglades as supplemental curriculum with a prescribed plan and assessments from the Everglades test bank with probes already created in Schoolnet.
- Standards-based planning to include small group instruction supported by Tammy Barton, Mathematics Specialist.
- Mathematics/Science Coaches assigned to schools to coach teachers and to work with small groups of students.
- Classroom walkthroughs with the Mathematics Specialist and school administration.
- Data analysis and instructional adjustments based upon the data supported by Mathematics Specialist, TSAs, and Coaches.

SCIENCE SPECIFIC CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTIONAL SUPPORT

- Standards-based planning supported by Jennifer Montoya, Elementary Science TSA, on a bi-monthly schedule for 5th Grade Teachers and monthly for 3rd and 4th Grade Teachers.
- Classroom walkthroughs with the Elementary Science TSA and school administration.
- Data analysis and instructional adjustments based upon the data supported by Elementary Science TSA and Coaches.
