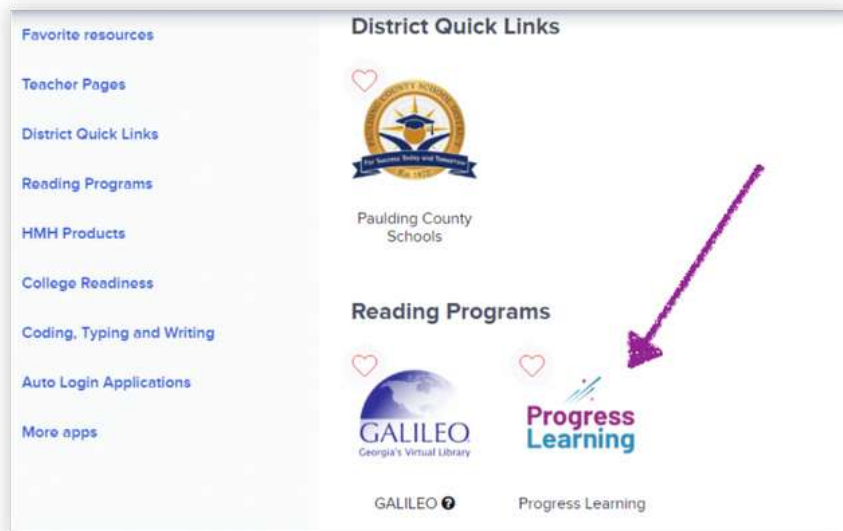


Summer Learning Opportunities through Progress Learning for 2nd Grade - 5th Grade

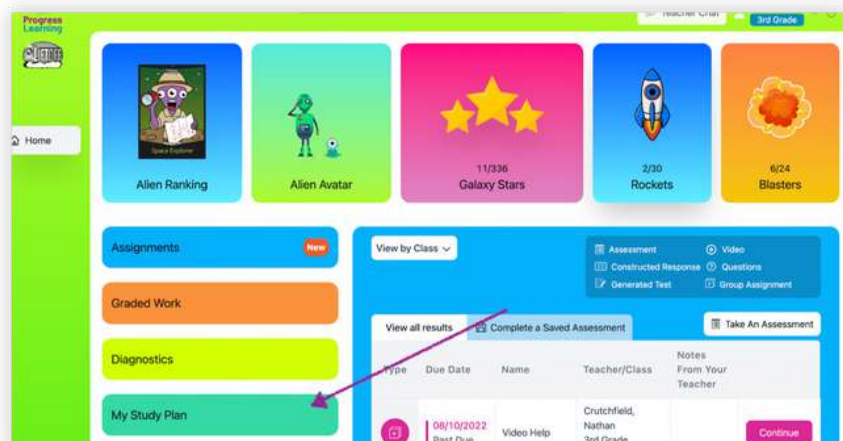
How do I get my child logged in?

Students will log in to Clever from the student dashboard on the school district website and then click on the Progress Learning app.



What activities can my child do on their own? (2-5)

Your child can complete various activities like practice questions and instructional videos. Students will do this by navigating to their "Study Plan" on the left side of the page and choosing a subject area.



How Does My Student Use Progress Learning?

Students can review and practice by selecting "Learn" and "Practice" from their Study Plan for each subject. Students can view videos, complete practice questions, and review their mistakes from the detailed results screen at the end of each activity.
