

- **Hudson K-12**

- **Northwest Elementary School / Hudson Elementary**

- Construction Begins Summer 2020, re-opens August 2021
- Rezoning and portable plan

- **Hudson Middle School**

- Construction Begins Summer 2021, re-opens 2022

- **Hudson High School**

- Construction Begins Summer 2021, completes August 2023

# Hudson K-12

## Proposed grade configurations

- Pre-K through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade
- 4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade
- 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade
  - Capacity for tailored space for wraparound services
  - Include access for PCPT
  - Enhance walkability of campus

In addition to high engagement and differentiation, students are supported as a whole child inside and outside the classroom.


E




