- **Lockers for 10th, 11th and 12th** - Students who paid for lockers last year can pick up their locker combination at Orientation. If you did not get your locker, you can get it at Orientation. Please bring \$5 cash for your lock. If you are unable to attend any Orientation, see Dean Beech at lunch during the first week of school.
- **Parking Passes** - If you purchased a pass last year, you can pick up your pass at Orientation; they will not be sold at Orientation. You must clear any book debts before you can get your parking pass. Dean Beech will be available at lunch during the first week of school to answer any questions.
- **Books** will be distributed during the first week of school, not during Orientation. You must clear any book debts at Orientation before you can get your schedule.

Students, parents/guardians, teachers, counselors, administrators, and office staffs all have important roles to play in our schools. With so many people working together, problems may occur from time to time. Rules have been made to address these problems. Like laws, rules apply to everyone, and they work only when everyone knows what they are.

This booklet lists the district rules for students in St. Johns County. The rules apply to all activities occurring on school grounds, on other sites being used for school activities and for any vehicles authorized for the transporting of students. Please read them. Since parents/guardians can be held responsible for the actions of their children, it is important that they are aware of the rules and consequences if the rules are broken. Parents, students, school faculty and staff need to know the rules.

Parents need to become involved in the education of their children and have the responsibility to provide the school with the current emergency contact person and/or telephone numbers. They also have the responsibility to notify the school of anything (such as medical information) that may affect their child's ability to learn, to attend school regularly, or to take part in school activities. As a parent, you also authorize designated St. Johns County School District personnel and St. Johns County Health Department School Health personnel to provide emergency care for your child and to exchange medical information as necessary to support the continuity of care of your child. Parents should also take special notice of the Attendance section of this Booklet as well as the Suspension and Expulsion provisions, which are in accordance with School Board Rule.

Signed forms must be part of every student's record. Your signature means that you have read this booklet and understand the rules. (It does not mean that you agree or disagree with them.)

All forms must be signed by parent/guardian and student and returned to school.

PSAT Score Report Payment Form

Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test

The date for the PSAT will be Wednesday, October 19, 2016. The test is given to 9th-11th graders during school hours. Students are automatically signed up for the test, but the state only pays for the 10th grade students to receive their results. If any 9th or 11th grade students want to receive their score reports, they must pay a **\$20 fee no later than September 1st. ONLY the tests of those students who pay in advanced will be sent in for scoring.** If you are interested in receiving your 9th or 11th grader's scores/results, please complete the information below and turn it in with a check made out to PVHS at the PSAT station/table during orientation. After orientation, your check can be turned in at the front desk. Your cancelled check will be your receipt of payment.

BENEFITS

- **Prepare for the SAT**
The PSAT/NMSQT and SAT measure the same skills and have the same format, directions, and questions.
- **Enter Scholarship and Recognition Programs**
For 11th grade students, this is the one and only chance to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Program. This program is very prestigious and can qualify the student for many scholarship opportunities
- **Plan for College and Careers**
Students who take the PSAT/NMSQT receive free access to My College Quick Start, a personalized online college planning kit, and My Road, a comprehensive major and career exploration tool that includes a personality profiler to help students find programs that fit their interests.
- **Receive Information from Colleges**
Through the Student Search Service (SSS), PSAT/NMSQT participants can receive free admissions and financial aid information from colleges, universities, and scholarship programs.
- **Improve their Skills**
The PSAT/NMSQT Score Report Plus gives students comprehensive, personalized feedback on their test performance, which allows them to see which questions they answered incorrectly and which academic skills require remediation.

WHY IS YOUR DONATION CRITICAL TO THE SUCCESS OF PVHS ATHLETICS?

The St. Johns County School District does not allocate funds to any county high school athletic program. The twenty-two sports at Ponte Vedra High School are funded in part by the Athletic Department in the form of proceeds from gate revenue, facility rentals and contributions. The remainder of the funds (roughly 85% of the total annual cost) required to support the athletics at PVHS comes directly from the PV Sharks Booster Club.

Reiterating, 85% of the funding for PVHS Athletics comes from donations from parents and corporate sponsors!

HOW DOES THIS WORK?

Each individual sport is funded by its own Team Booster Club, which operates under the umbrella of the General Booster Club. When you donate, about 85-90% of the funds go to your sport(s) of choice, with the remainder going to General Boosters.

The Team Booster Club supports expenses specifically related to that sport: uniforms, travel, meals, equipment, etc. Depending on the sport, these expenses can be from about \$200 per player to over \$1000 per player. In instances where the team goes deep into the playoffs, this number rises dramatically as travel expenses are incurred.

The General Booster Club supports a broad range of requirements, such as maintenance and capital improvements to playing venues, cross-sport infrastructure projects, and operating expense shortfalls for the Athletic Department (usually 4-5 months of funding at the end of every school year). These annual obligations average \$30-40,000/year.

Your support, through membership and other fundraising activities of the PV Sharks Booster Club, is essential to keeping our athletes on the field. We encourage you to join the booster club and become part of the support behind our young athletes.

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT THAT I DONATE NOW?

In the first kickoff meeting for your student's sport, you will likely be notified of a suggested donation number, which is the projected cost per student to field a team. You can ask someone from last year's team or the coach if you need an estimate of what this level will be. Instead of waiting until winter or spring to sign up, it makes sense to sign up now and receive the benefits of Booster Club membership (see next page for all benefits). If your student, or the family, enjoys going to games throughout the year, why pay \$5-7 entrance fees if you can obtain free passes by signing up now instead of later?
