Check-in/Check-out

Students have to check-in and check-out through the Attendance Office

Check-in

Students must sign in through the Attendance Office when they arrive at school after 8:35 am.

Check-out

- When checking a student out you will need to provide the students <u>ID</u> number and your picture <u>ID</u>. *Tip: store your student's ID number in your phone.
- If it is necessary for a student to check-out early due to illness, the student must be seen by the school nurse.
- The latest a student can check-out is 3:30 pm. Students will not be allowed to check-out after this time.
- When sending a detailed email requesting that your student be checked-out by someone not listed in our database, the email must originate from the parent's email address that we have on file.
- Students cannot be checked-out over the phone
