The first week of school at Lake Mary High was full of excitement with 2,700 students attending school for in-person learning. Our faculty hit the ground running by engaging students in their lessons, and students seemed very excited to get back to school, get settled into their new classes, and reconnect with friends.

In spite of all the back to school excitement, I realize that many students and families are worried about the spread of COVID. According to guidance from the Seminole County Department of Health, vaccinations and face coverings are recommended as the best way to keep students safe. SCPS has resumed tracking student cases through a COVID Dashboard, and this dashboard can be found at https://www.scps.k12.fl.us/covid19/dashboard.stml. As of Friday afternoon, LMHS had 10 active COVID cases among students. As a reminder about contact tracing, our COVID Safety Manager, Mr. Michael Hennessy, conducts contact tracing for each positive case, and students who are not vaccinated and were less than 6-feet away from the positive student for 15 minutes or more are required to quarantine.

In other news, athletic competition begins this week with pre-season games in girls volleyball, varsity football, cross country, and boys and girls golf. Details about all athletic competitions are included in the Athletic Department Update each week in this newsletter.

In addition to athletics ramping up this week, many of our clubs are beginning to hold meetings after school. Students should listen to morning announcements, follow LMHS social media, and reference our website to stay informed about upcoming opportunities. in Student Services.



Save the Date

The ACT will be given to all 11th grade students on Tuesday, October 5 during the school day.

The PSAT will be given to all 9th-11th grade students on Wednesday, October 13 during the school day.

The SAT will be given to all 12th grade students on Wednesday, October 13 during the school day. Students can set up a College Board account at www.collegeboard.org and can link their account to Khan Academy where they have access to official SAT practice items.

Students will not need to register for these assessments and there will be no charge. More information will be sent out closer to the testing dates.

Advanced Placement Exams

Students who are currently enrolled in an Advanced Placement course will register for the exam through a College Board online process. All students are required to take the AP exam for the AP courses in which they are enrolled. Students will receive the exam order information in their AP class(es).
