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
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
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HOPE Online Disclaimer

Rising 9th Grade Residency Verification



- Residency verification begins the week of March 23rd for the 2020-2021 school year.
 (Snapcode will be sent out throughout the week by the District.)
- All rising 9th graders must show proof of residency. (this includes academy students)
- Students that are not verified will <u>not</u> be provided a high school schedule.
- June or prior (Contact Middle School)
- July or after (Contact High School)
- 2 (required) + 1 (additional) = 3 (total records)

Freshman Day-July 30th

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
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
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
