## COURSE INFORMATION

**Health:** Semester elective teaching skills to become health literate and to practice responsible behaviors for a healthy lifestyle. This comprehensive course focuses on the health issues core to the optimum development of adolescents. Required by all 6<sup>th</sup> grade students

**Physical Education** (PE): Semester elective provides students with the knowledge, skills, and values to become healthy and physically active. Required locker fee, daily participation and appropriate attire. Optional uniform fee.

**Orientation to Agriculture**: Semester elective for students that would like to begin to learn about and work with livestock, plants, natural resources along with other agriculture systems.

**Art in World Cultures:** Semester elective explores art from around the world through project-based, handson activities. Students reinterpret selected forms to promote understanding of themes, purposes, and symbolism.

**Business Keyboarding:** Semester elective that uses software to increase student typing speed while teaching the proper technique and business skills.

Career Research and Decision Making: Semester elective provides knowledge and skills in the research process with emphasis on determining and refining research questions.

**Exploratory Spanish**: Semester elective introduces students to Spanish and its culture. Students learn beginning skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills while broadening exposure and appreciation for Spanish cultural similarities and differences.

**AVID** (Advancement Via Individual Determination): Yearlong college-readiness elective ensures students "in the academic middle" succeed in rigorous courses. Provides organization skills, time management, note-taking strategies, college tutors in class, and field trips to local colleges. Must submit separate application to apply for this elective. Requires at least one advanced class.

**Band**: This exciting year-long class teaches students how to play a band instrument. Students will learn fundamentals of performing a band instrument and experience the joys of performing in front of others in a concert setting. Students will need their own instrument. However, many instruments are available from the school at no charge.

**Chorus:** This year-long class teaches students the fundamentals of how to sing. Students will learn basic vocal technique, critical and creative thinking skills, and an appreciation for music from around the world. Students will also have the opportunity to perform for our community and school.

## Physical Education Requirement - Waiver

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Florida state legislation requires students in grades 6-8 to take at least one semester of physical education each year. The legislation allows for parents to waive the requirement if the student meets at least one of the following:

- The student is enrolled or required to enroll in a remedial course (waiver not required)
- The parent requests that the student enroll in another elective course offered by the school at that grade level (if available).
- The student is participating in physical activities outside of the school day that, which are equal or in excess of the mandated requirement.
