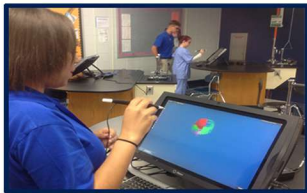
Liberty County School System Goals

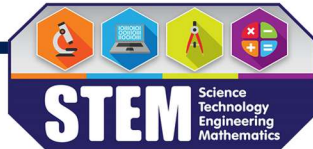

The Georgia Student Health Survey is a survey that is administered yearly to students in grades 3-12.
