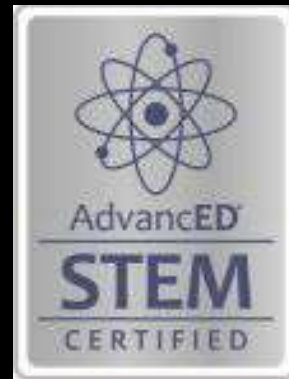

Courses you should register for:

01

Honors Biology

This should be listed with a (STEM) at the end.

02

Scientific Research

Leave an elective spot open and we will add in this course here if your teacher did not recommend it for you.

03

Geometry Honors or Accl Geo B/Alg II

This should be listed with (STEM) at the end.

04

9th Lit/Comp Honors

This does not have to be honors but is in 98% of all STEM students.

05

Elective

We highly encourage our students to take AP Human Geography

06

Elective

Foreign Language (2 Consecutive are required)

07

Elective

Health/PE

Health and PE Options

Some students who are involved in sports, band, theater, art and other activities that require an elective spot, choose to take PE/Health in alternate ways.

- **Option 1:** Take these courses in traditional class format during your 9th grade year. All rising 9th graders will be automatically enrolled in these courses by their 8th grade counselor. Cost: Free.
- **Option 2:** Take these courses in traditional class format in 10th, 11th, or 12th grade. You will need to waive out of the courses for 9th grade during the waiver window that opens March 8th.
 - You will need to waive into these courses during the waiver window for the year that you want to take the classes.
 - You will not be automatically enrolled in these classes after 9th grade; you must waive in. Cost: Free.
- ★ **Option 3:** Many STEM students choose this option to open up space in their schedule. Take these courses at an outside independent study program during a summer, fall, or spring semester.

This does not guarantee that your child's schedule will be perfect in the Fall as the computer sometimes decides to override what has been entered by us.

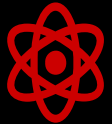


What is the Waiver Process?



Waive OUT

Decided not to take Health and PE or a non STEM elective course? Waive out and enter the course you desire to enter.



Waive IN

Do you want to take additional academic courses? Waive IN to additional academics or AP level non STEM courses.

Please note: Students may NOT waive into a STEM designated course! Those are only allowed via Teacher Recommendations.

What should you see?

In the portal

*“Requested units” will likely read (60/70) until FCHS adds the required Scientific Research (STEM) course. Our scheduler will be adding this for you. It may or may not show up prior to the closing of the elective window.
