Demographics: W. Reily Brown's population is comprised of 439 students. W. Reily Brown's student population is comprised of 72% low income students, 25.1% special education (including all of the district's most at risk learners-level IV) students, and 4% ELL students. Their race index includes 38% African American, 37% White, 12% Hispanic, 12% Multi-Racial and 1% Asian. As previously indicated, 34% of their teachers have four years or less experience, 9% have 5-9 years, 30% have 10-19 years, 15% have 20-24 years of experience, and only 9% have 25 years of experience.

Abstract: W.R. Brown Elementary School extends their professional development beyond a typical professional learning community. Each month, lesson study teams gather to plan and research a lesson and agree which team member will teach the lesson and in what classroom (other than their own) it will be taught. The next day, the lesson study team members are released from their classroom duties to observe the lesson and collect data on teacher actions and student responses. It is a process that deepens the interaction of a school's professional learning community by developing the habits of self-reflection and critical thinking through personal collaboration with their colleagues and structured observations of their students.

Data: Data has been collected through lesson study implementation, weekly walkthroughs of teachers, formative evaluations, one on one quarterly data conferences with each teacher, PLC data, monthly cause data (number of writing to learn strategies used, number of minutes of writing instruction, number of one-on-one writing conferences, number of collaboratively scored writing pieces collected throughout the year and RTI intervention data.
