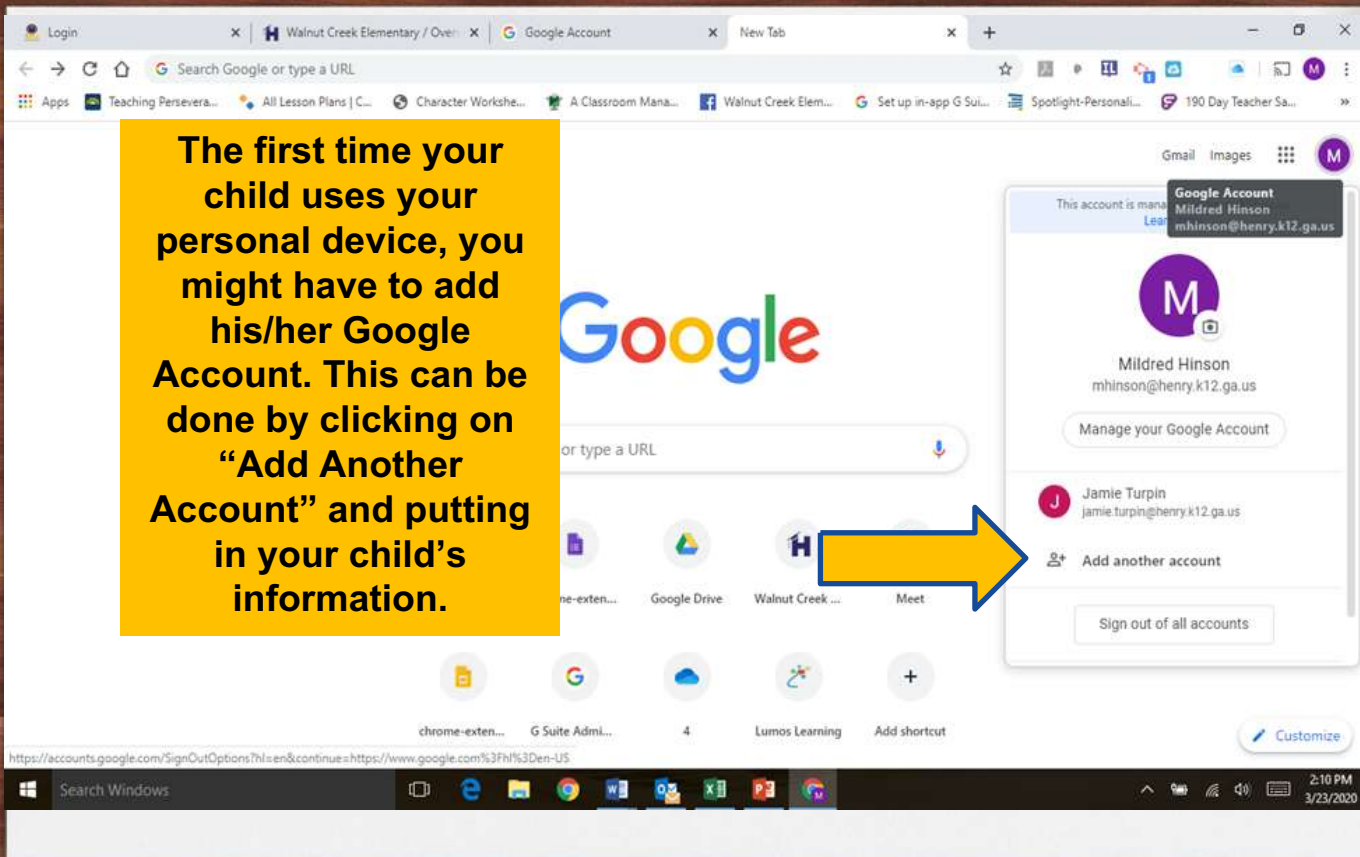
How To Access
CLASSLINK FROM A
PERSONAL DEVICE



For ClassLink to work properly when you are using your personal device, your child must be signed on to his/her Google Account and be using Google as the browser.

You can check to see if your child is signed in under his/her Google Account by following the directions on the next slides.

The first time your child uses your personal device, you might have to add his/her Google Account. This can be done by clicking on “Add Another Account” and putting in your child’s information.

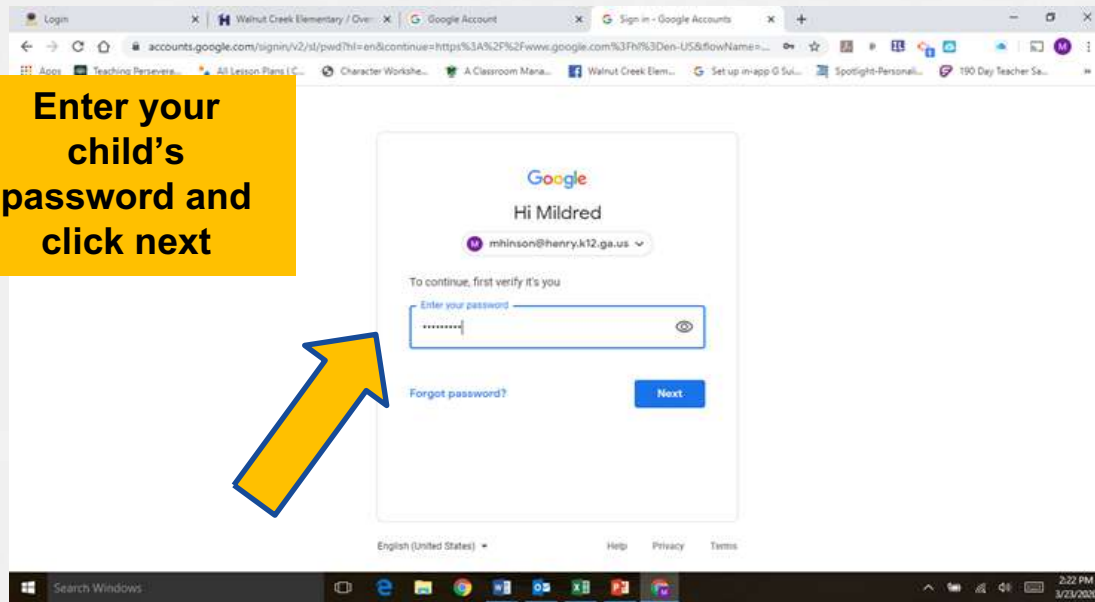


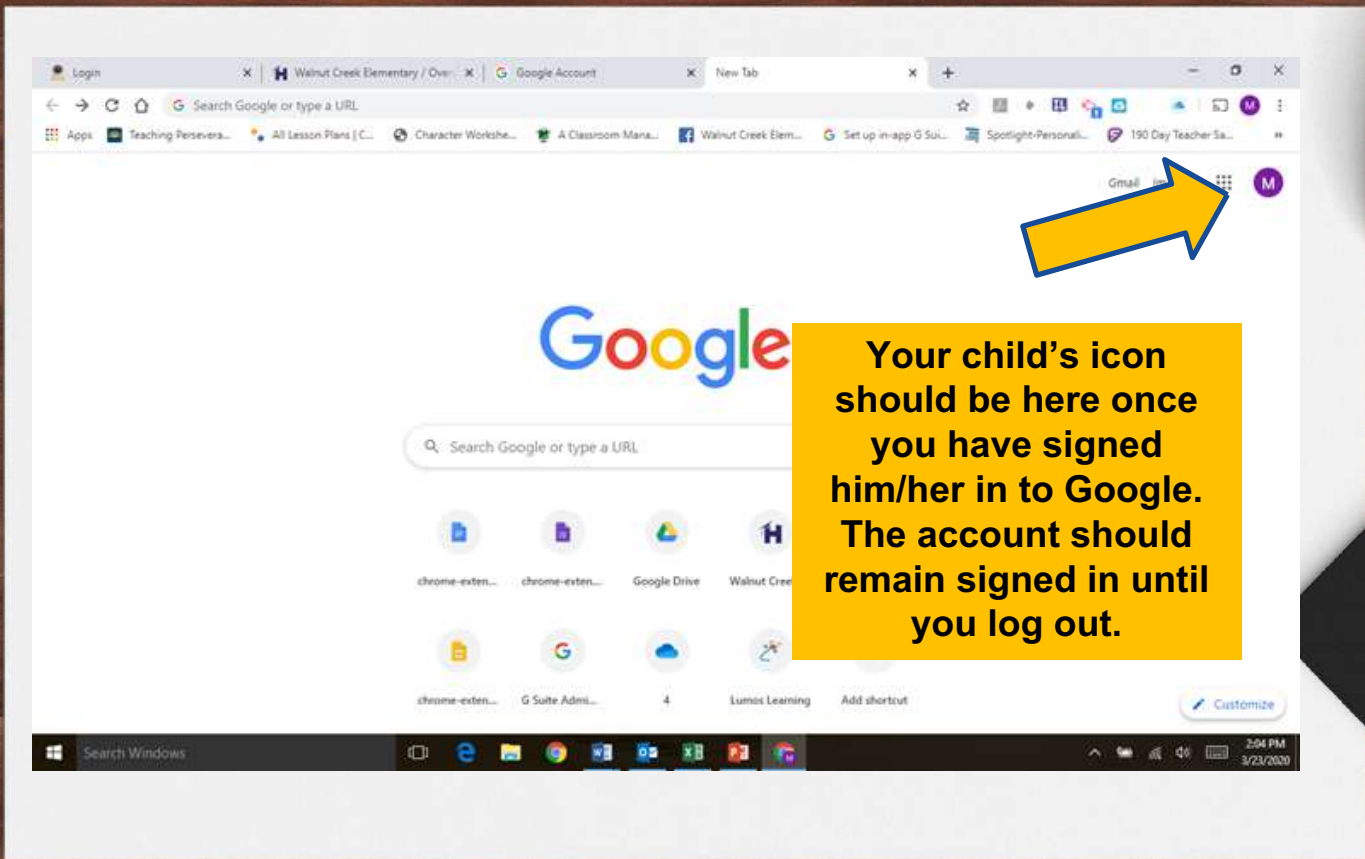
To add your child's account, type in his/her school email address in this box and click next



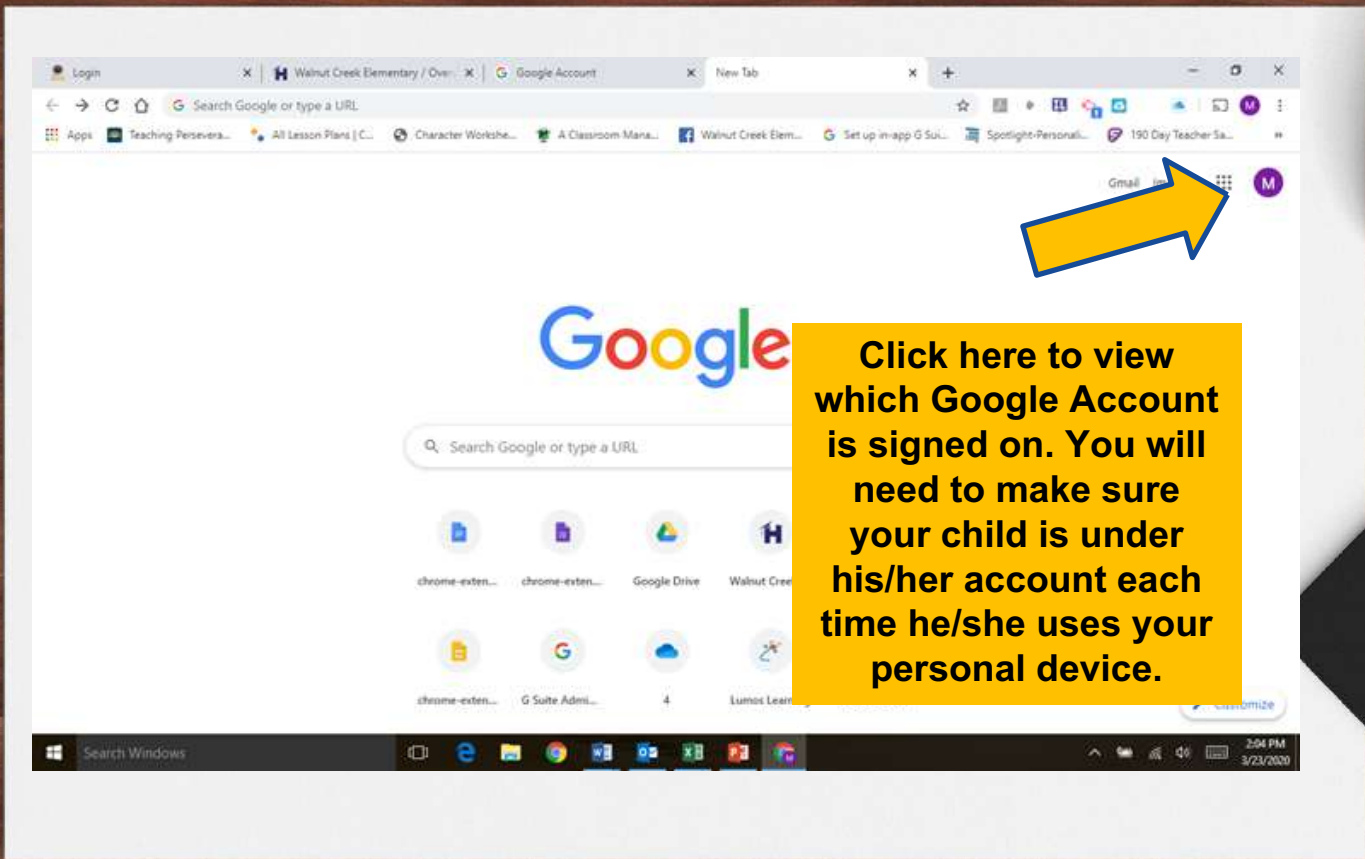

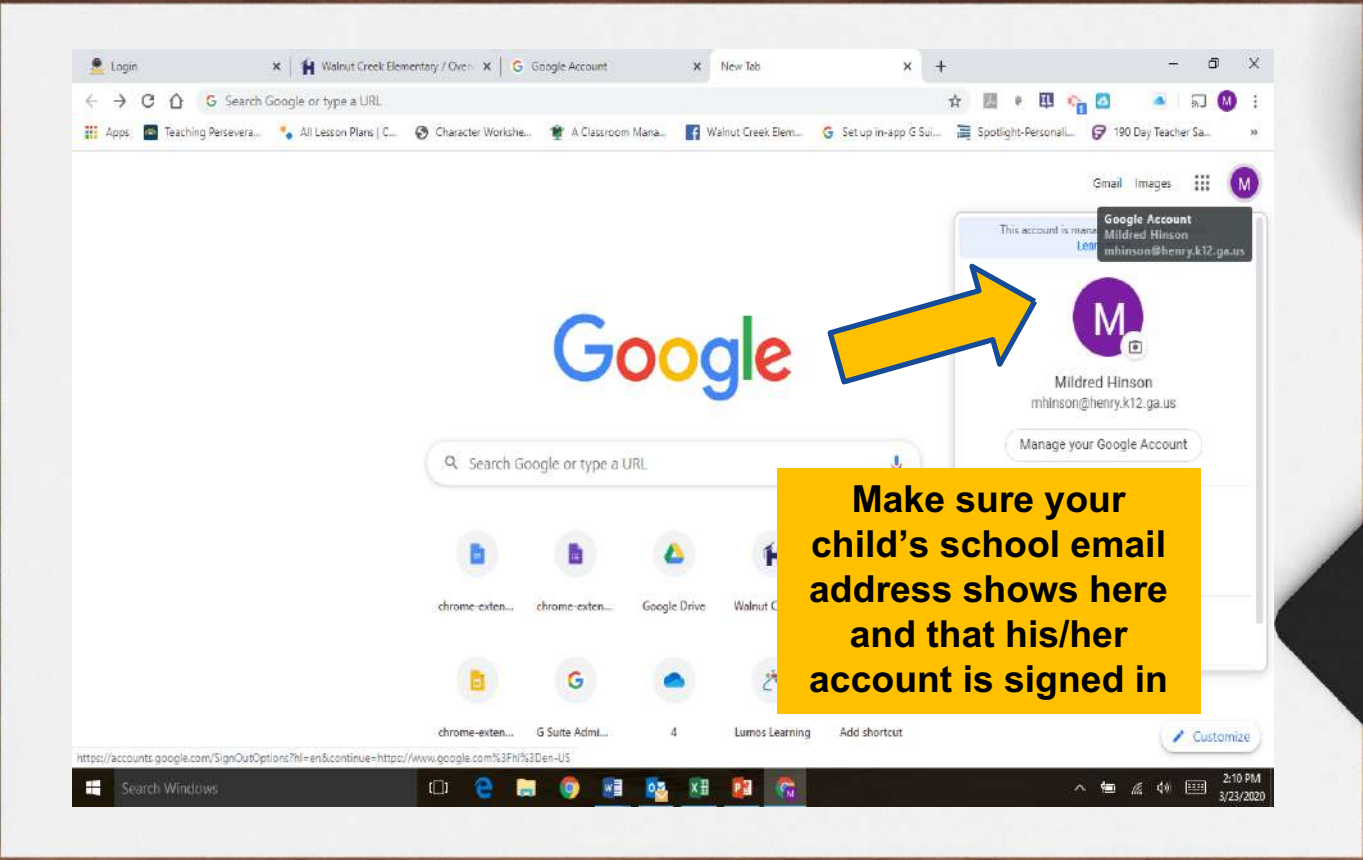




Your child's icon should be here once you have signed him/her in to Google. The account should remain signed in until you log out.



Click here to view which Google Account is signed on. You will need to make sure your child is under his/her account each time he/she uses your personal device.



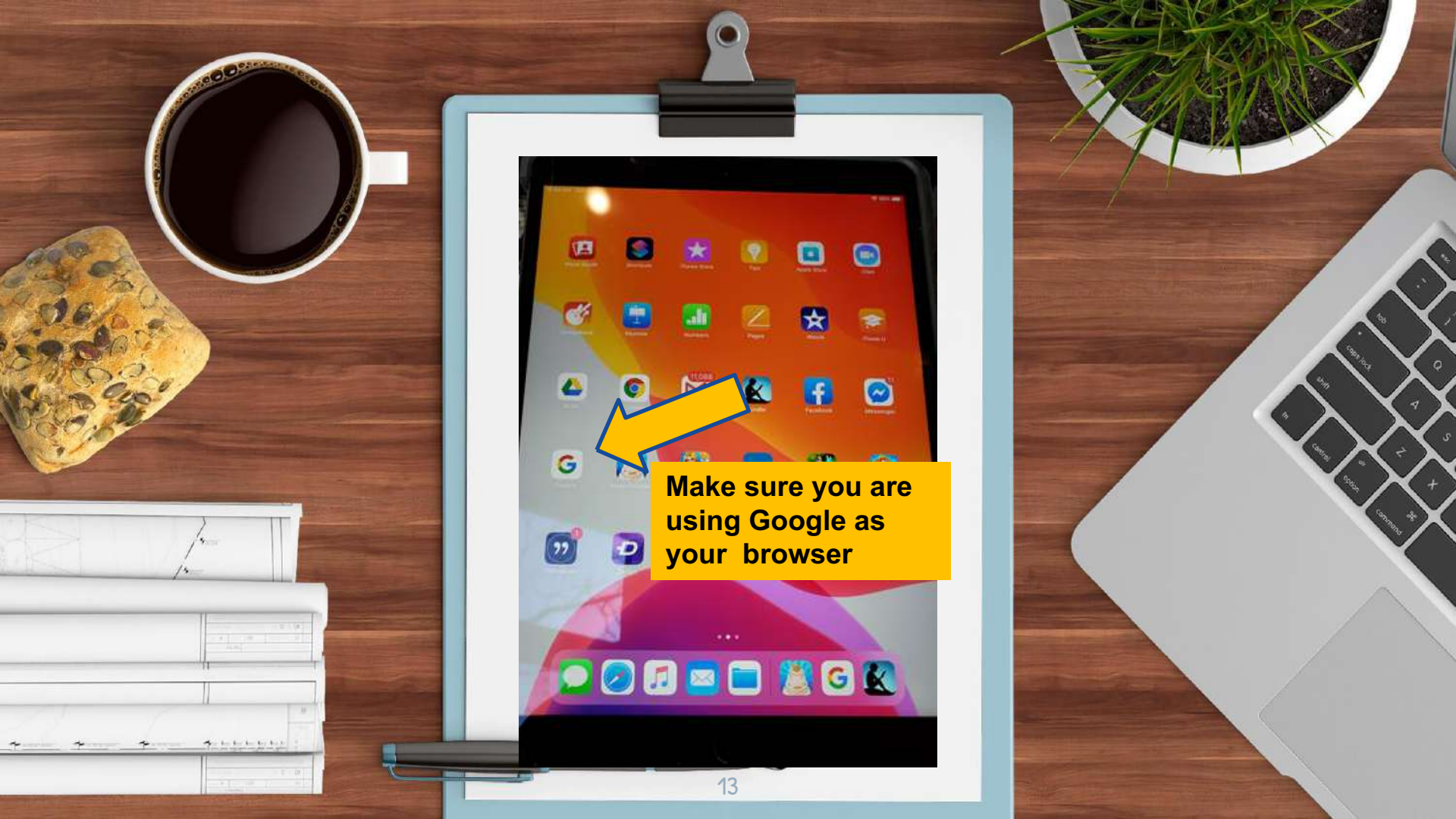


STEP-BY-STEP FOR SCHOOL OWNED DEVICES

- Go the dashboard/launchpad
- Type in user name (just the student number)
- Type in password (first initial, last initial, two digits for month of birth, two digits for day of birth and two digits for year, #) Example: Child's Name Jane Doe
Child's Date of Birth 2/14/2014 would be jd021414#
- Then hit enter and you should be taken to Launchpad
- See next slide for example

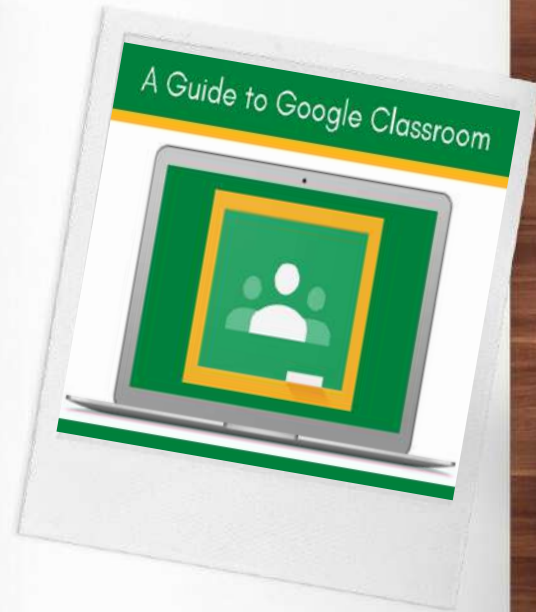

USING GOOGLE CLASSROOM

- Sign-in to ClassLink through the APP or Launchpad
- Once signed in, click on the Google Classroom icon
- Your child may have more than one classroom come up, select the classroom you want to enter
- Click on the icon for the classroom you want to enter

Make sure that you are in Google as your browser. Classroom does not work in other browsers.

USING GOOGLE CLASSROOM

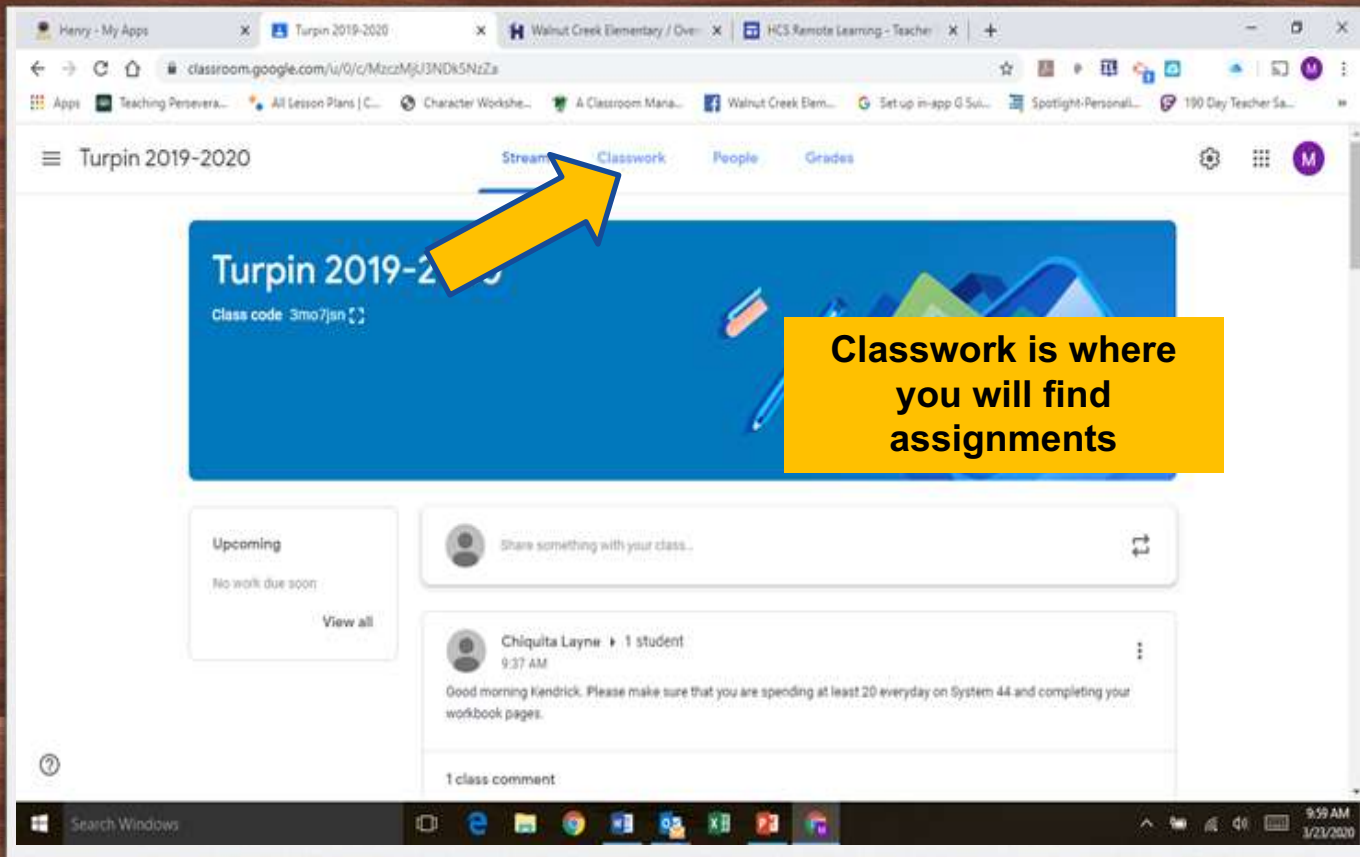
- > Google Classroom is presently being used in grade 3-5 and some specials
- > Your child accesses Google Classroom through ClassLink (directions on the previous slides)
- > Once your child has signed on to ClassLink, then he/she can go directly to Google Classroom through an icon on the Launchpad

TROUBLESHOOTING TIPS

ClassLink


- > Must be signed on through Google (other browsers do not work)
- > If using the app, must be on the HCS link
- > Only user name, not entire email address

Google Classroom


- > Only used in grade 3-5
- > Must be signed on through ClassLink
- > Must be in Google browser
- > Contact your child's teacher for problems with Google Classroom

Other programs


- > Contact your child's teacher for help with programs they might be using that are not on HCS ClassLink

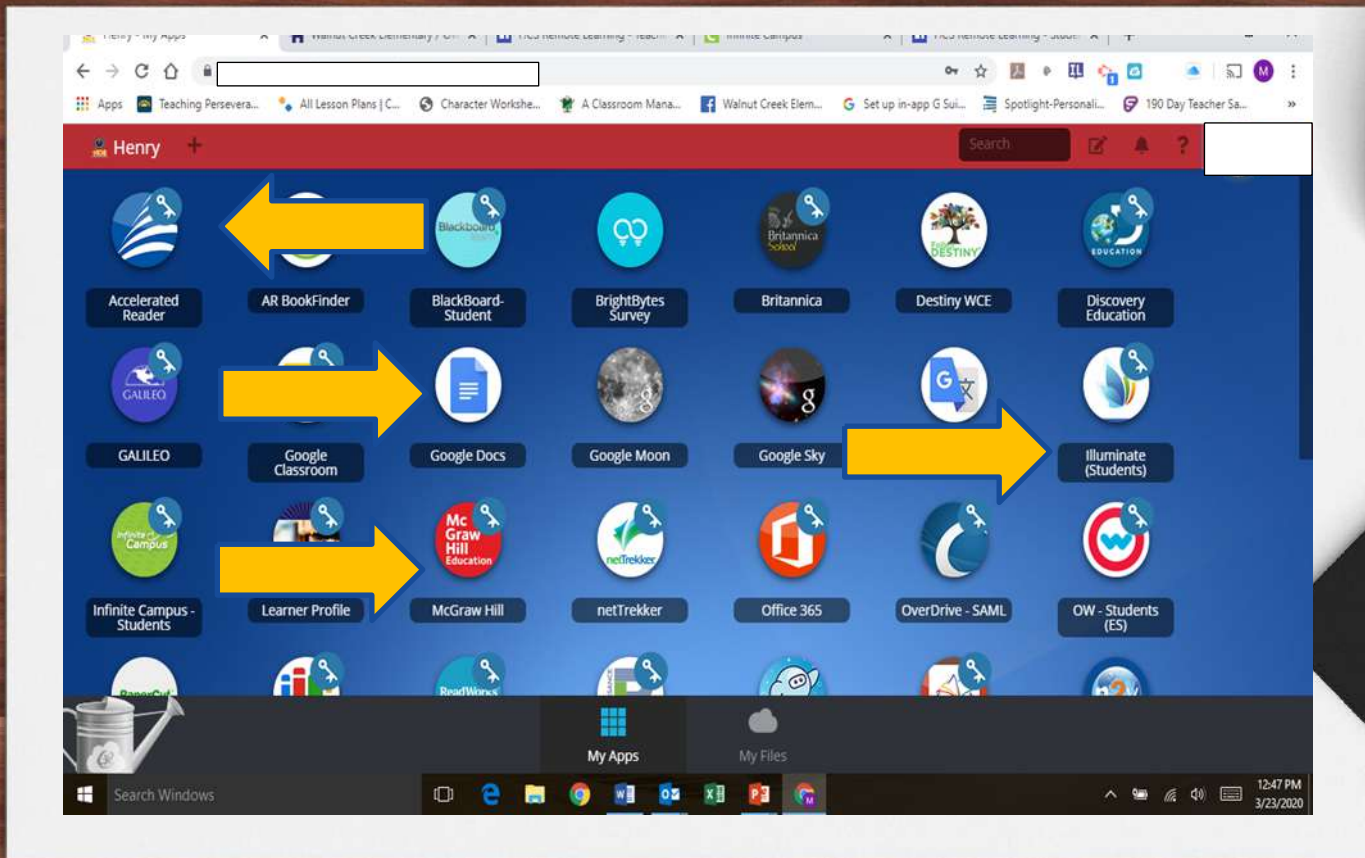

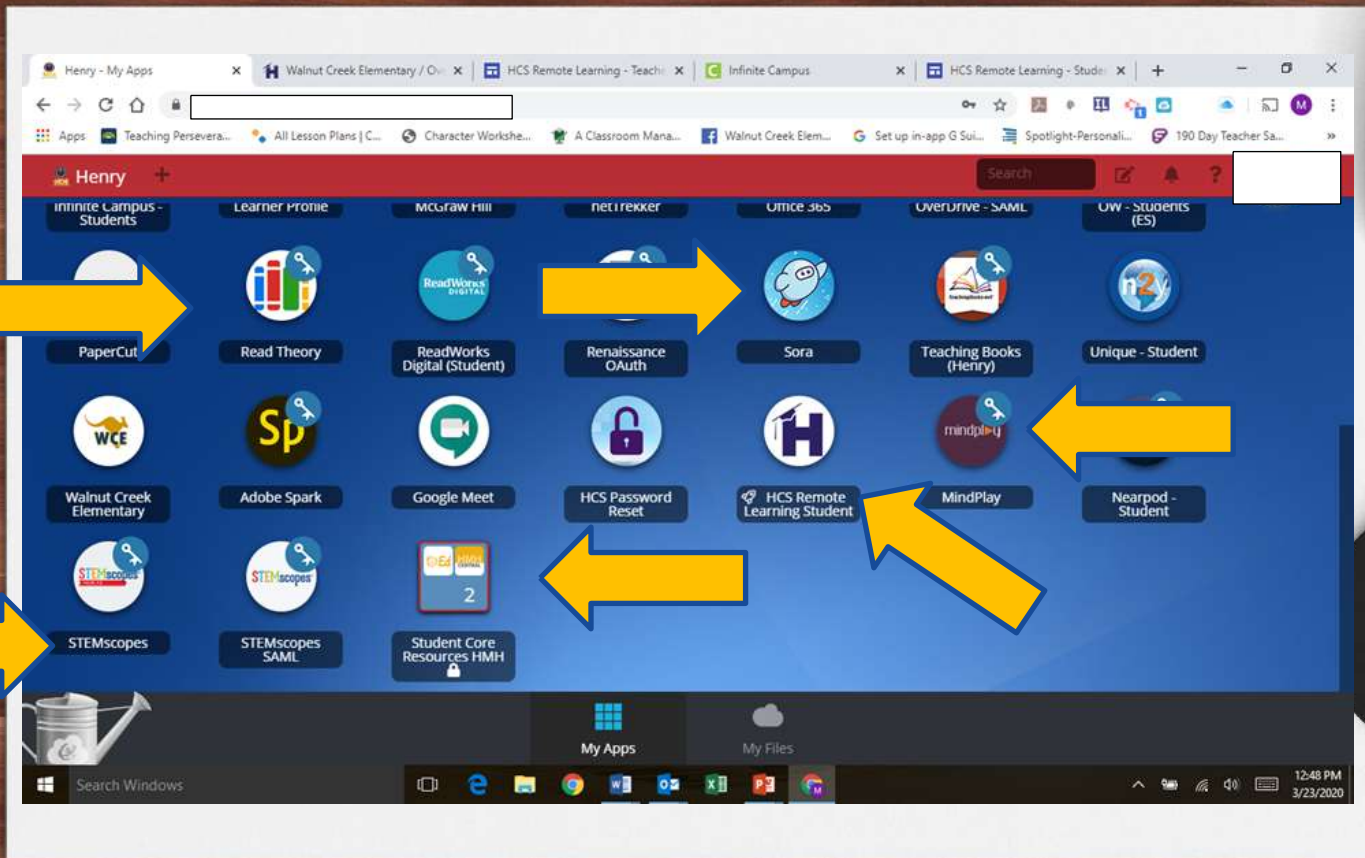
