- 8/24 – 9/11 Phase II** Distance Learning- All students (including Opt In's) may access Distance Learning with their teacher. If or when we return to a Blended F2F model again, Opt In Families will be able to continue their Opt In status through Sem. 1.
- 9/14 – 10/2 Phase III** 9/8 DOE decision expected Re: extending Distance Learning or moving back to original school models

It is not required that your child(ren) come to campus 8/17-8/20. Please inform your child's teacher if not coming.

Generally, what can we expect? (Students **should not** bring their personal devices to campus for their assigned day.)

1. If you will not be sending your child to campus as scheduled above, please inform your child's teacher.
2. You may pick up consumables and opening of year packets, on Friday 8/21 from 9-12, if you keep your child home.
3. Your child will receive and bring home the annual Opening of Year DOE/School Packet to Review and Fill out.
4. Your child will be receiving their consumables. i.e. planner and any workbooks.
5. We will be using our regular bell schedule for 2020-2021 from 8:00-11:00.
6. Grab and Go school breakfast will be available from 7:30-7:55 via the dining room food line.
7. Grab and Go school lunches will be available from 11:00-11:30 via Mauka/Caf parking automobile drive through.
8. There is no before or after school care.
9. There is no before school supervision on campus. Please drop your child off between 7:50-8:00. (7:30 for school breakfast)
10. There is no after school supervision. Please make arrangements to pick up your child immediately after school (11am)

What should my child bring? (Devices will be provided in classroom for their scheduled time. No Personal Devices are needed)

1. Their backpack to take home the various consumables and opening of year packet. (Please label with first / last name)
2. If they have not done so already, please have your child bring in their labeled school supplies.
3. Their most familiar and most comfortable face coverings and water bottle. (Please label with first / last name)

What might my child be doing for their one day on campus? Teachers will....

1. Welcome your child back to school.
2. Reconnect and establish relationships.
3. Review wellness practices and safety information.
4. Orient students to their new classroom and its routines.
5. Review distance learning practices and expectations.
6. Provide an overview of what to expect during distance learning.
7. Explore the different online programs students may access while distance learning.
8. Provide opportunities for students to practice logging in to Acellus and other school-based programs.
9. Orient students to the various ways they can communicate with their teacher when not on campus.

What might my child be doing on the other Phase I days and during Distance Learning after Phase I?

1. Assigned steps, special lessons, assessments and writing assignments on the Acellus platform.
2. Baseline diagnostic assessments from teacher directed sources. i.e. iReady etc.
3. Other original activities including but not limited to: Kidbiz, Wonders, Stepping Stones, Brain Pop, Mystery Science etc.
