#### Math

Elementary School:

Students who score a mid to high 3, or a 4 or 5 on the spring FSA will be placed in accelerated (advanced) math. If you do not wish for your child to be placed in an accelerated (advanced) math class, it is your responsibility to email your child's school counselor BEFORE May 6, 2022. After that date, Math placement will be very difficult to change.

#### **GEMS**

Students who take GEMS in 6th grade will take Algebra 1 Honors in 7th grade and Geometry Honors in 8th grade. Both are high school credits and will be factored into your student's overall high school GPA, and grades will appear on their transcripts as high school academic electives. Students on this path must take 4 additional math credits in high school. Please review the math progression plan on the back of the parent letter.

#### iSeries Courses

The Student Progression Plan requires iJourney (semester course) and either iConnect (semester course) or iChallenge (semester or year long course).

Rock Lake Middle School presents the Raider Triple Crown Challenge: Over the course of your middle school career, take iJourney, iConnect and iChallenge and

- Earn an overall A, B, or C grade for each course
- Take certification exams in all three courses
