As a member in good standing, you will be expected to continue to demonstrate, develop, and strengthen these qualities through your participation in chapter service projects, activities, and meetings.

Your Rights:

1. To receive recognition from the school and community.
2. To receive a fair hearing by the faculty committee before any action may be taken against your membership.

Your Responsibilities:

1. To enroll and remain in a fully academic curriculum.
2. To maintain a 3.5 cumulative semester grade point average (GPA) in your core academic classes.
3. To attend regular, special, and committee meetings and hearings.
4. To participate in NJHS fundraising projects.
5. To participate in NJHS community and special service projects. To volunteer for a minimum of 20 hours of service in these projects (10 hours of which should be for a school in our community, 5 hours outside the school district, and 5 hours your choice).
6. To actively demonstrate and develop qualities of leadership, service, and character.
7. To pay annual dues of \$20.00.
