ELA	1oth Grade Lit - 10055y 1oth Grade Lit Honors - 10065y	Students will select their ELA course for next year. 10th Grade Lit and 10th Grade Honors both cover the Ga Standards of Excellence for 10th grade. Students selecting the Honors level course should be prepared for a faster pace of content, reading more complex text, and writing more frequently; however, successful completion of either level will allow for students to select either 10th Grade Lit or 10th Grade Lit Honors as sophomores.			
SOCIAL STUDIES	— World History - 40575y — World History Honors - 40585y — AP World History - 40135y	Students will select their Social Studies course for next year. World History is offered in a variety of levels of rigor to support students beginning to expand their exposure to reading and writing assignments that challenge their learning. Students seeking AP World History should be prepared for intensive vocabulary work, a dedicated outside of school commitment to homework completion and preparation for assessments. Students do not have to have completed AP Human Geography to select AP World History as sophomores; however, they should be prepared for an increased expectation for independent study, time spent on course work outside of class, and the elevated writing and reading requirements for this course.			
WORLD LANG.	Students will select their World Language Course. Two consecutive years of a world language are required for admission to a 4-year college in Georgia; however, World Language courses are classified as electives for High School graduation. Spanish BLOCK Courses - Students seeking to accelerate their language study may elect to take two periods of Spanish next year. More details on these courses are available here. Students seeking a World Language course not listed here should request that course through the Course Waiver form.
