...a student wants to take a class and they don't see it as an option to select in the portal?	Please complete the course waiver form.
...a student is recommended for a course they no longer want to take?	Please complete the course waiver form.
...a student is planning to take a class over the summer to accelerate their learning and need to change a course recommended for them?	Please complete the course waiver form.
...a student is planning to take a course over the summer to accelerate their learning and <u>cannot select</u> the level of course they are seeking?	Please complete the course waiver form.
...a student does not see any Science or Math course recommended by their teacher, what should they do?	Please complete the course waiver form.
...a student wants to know about when they can request virtual classes?	Students seeking part time virtual options will be able to request those platforms when we have more information about that process - we anticipate mid March.
