CHOOSING COURSES ONLINE

Please use the instructions below to choose electives for the 2021-2022 school year. **There will not be a face to face registration this year** so this will be the ONLY way students can choose electives for next school year.

Step 1: Log into **STUDENT** HAC account using student username and password, **NOT PARENT login.**

Step 2: Select “Classes”

Step 3: Select the “Request” tab

Step 4: Any course that is teacher recommended has a **lock** symbol next to it and cannot be changed. If students feel they have been recommended for the wrong course, students can fill out a core re-evaluation form- [CLICK HERE](#).

Step 5: Choose elective classes. **Total number of classes listed should be SEVEN.**

Step 6: All courses that students can choose from are listed under the “Electives” tab.

Step 7: To select a course, click edit on the far-right side of the ELECTIVE row and select the box next to the class or classes you wish to ADD. Then select SAVE.

Step 8: Once there is a total of 7 courses, you are done!

Step 9: If there is an elective course in HAC that a student does not want on their schedule, [CLICK HERE](#) to have it removed and replaced with another elective.

Step 10: If students still have question regarding their schedule or classes to choose for next year, students can make an appointment using the link below to meet with their school counselor to discuss selections.

CORE RE-EVALUATION FORM

All core courses must be recommended by the student’s current teacher in that subject. If students feel they have been recommended for the wrong course or if they want to take a

less rigorous course (Honors instead of AP or Standard instead of Honors), the student may fill out the core re-evaluation form [CLICK HERE](#).

If students meet the progression for the course, the counselor will approve it and students should be able to see the course in HAC prior to the end of the school year.

If students do not currently meet the progression, student's request will not be reviewed until final grades have been posted and test scores return over the summer.

ACADEMY COURSES

VIRTUAL CLASSES

Planning to take a virtual class next year? Please complete [THIS FORM](#) to have the BTHS course removed from HAC and the virtual lab added. Students must also request the course on FLVS or SJVS, with an August 10, 2021 start date, by June 10, 2021. **It is VERY IMPORTANT that students change their school of record in their FLVS account to Bartram Trail High School during the summer.**

Please Note: Students may only take one virtual period on campus at BTHS due to seat availability. Students can opt to take more than one course virtually but will not have more than one virtual lab.
