


Advanced Placement (AP) Courses

<u>Summer School Registration-Online</u>

Students can take Personal Fitness and Health through GAVS or Forsyth Virtual School during the summer.

More information with cost, links, and deadlines for both programs will be sent and posted when available.

Students planning to take H/PF during the summer need to "waive" out of those courses using the Google Waiver Form and request the course that will replace them.



<u>Summer School Registration-Online</u>

- Courses taken over the summer will not be calculated into your student's GPA, and will not make them eligible for additional AP courses. Freshman are only eligible to take AP Human Geography, regardless of credits earned.
- STUDENTS WILL NOT BE GUARANTEED AN ELECTIVE CHOICE BECAUSE THEY DECIDED TO TAKE THESE COURSES DURING THE SUMMER. ELECTIVES WILL BE CHOSEN BASED ON SEAT AVAILABILITY
