PROOF OF RESIDENCY

REGISTRATION CHECK OFF LIST:

We **must** have all residency before we can begin registration.

One (1) of the following:

- Current lease (all pages and signatures)
- Property tax statement (2014 only)
- Settlement statement (2014 or 2015 only)

One (1) of the following: (entire bill or service letter)

- Gas bill
- Electric (must be dated within the last 60 days)!

All must be in the name and address of the biological parent or legal guardian (must have court document showing guardianship)

If any are in the name of a step-parent, then parent must provide a copy of the marriage certificate at time of registration.

- Marriage Certificate

One (1) of the following:

- Parent driver's license
- Parent Identification card

Only biological parents or legal guardians may register students. (legal guardians must have court documents showing guardianship)

Once residency is provided, we will need the following with the completed registration packet:

- Completed registration form (must have to enroll)
- Students last report card from previous school and/or withdrawal document (must have to enroll)

The following documents are required but may be provided within the first 30 days of enrollment if not readily available at time of enrollment:

- Students birth certificate*
- Students social security card or signed objection waiver form*
- GA 3231 Immunization certificate*
- GA 3300 Eye, Ear, Dental certificate*

I understand that the items listed above must be provided within the time frame specified. If items are missing after the specified date, I understand that my child will be subject to withdrawal at that time from Luella Middle School.
