Role of Georgia Citizens

SS8CG1 The student will describe the role of citizens under Georgia's constitution.

- Describe the rights and responsibilities of citizens.

- A <u>citizen</u> is a member of a political system in which people have a voice in their government. People are citizens of all the jurisdictions in which they live. They can be citizens of their country, state, county, city, etc. Being a citizen allows you to participate in our government. This also means citizens must be aware of their rights and their responsibilities.
- <u>**Rights**</u> are standards that keep institutions from harming people's freedom. Such institutions may be governments, police forces, businesses, or other groups. The Bill of Rights in Georgia's Constitution lists the rights of the citizens. Along with these rights come certain responsibilities.
- **<u>Responsibility</u>** involves knowing that actions have consequences. People and institutions must control their actions, as their actions might harm other people.
