Welcome to the 2024 - 2025 school year at Graymont Grade School.

Our first day of school will be Wednesday August 14, 2024 with a regular school day. Graymont Grade School starts at 8:00 with a dismissal at 1:00 for Kindergarten, and 3:00 for 1 – 8 grade.

Breakfast and lunch menus are on the Rooks Creek website (www.rookscreek.k12.il.us), or Teacher Ease.

Registration in person is only required for new students to Graymont. Returning students need to bring the required paperwork and registration fee on the first day of school.

Only students who are residents of the District may attend Graymont Grade School without a tuition charge, except as otherwise provided by State Law. A student's residence is the same as the legal residency of the person who has legal custody of the student.

Bus routes will be sent home around the first week of August. If you do not receive one, please let me know. IF YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE RIDING THE BUS TO SCHOOL ON ANY DAY, PLEASE CALL THE OFFICE, (815)743-5346.

Immunizations, Health, and Dental Exams:

A student's parent(s)/guardian(s) shall present proof that the student received a health examination and the immunizations against and screenings for, preventable communicable diseases, as required by the Illinois Department of Health, within one year prior to:

- Entering kindergarten or first grade
- 2. Entering sixth and ninth grade
- 3. Enrolling in an Illinois school, regardless of the student's grade including nursery school, special education, Headstart programs operated by elementary or secondary schools, and students transferring into Illinois from out of state or out of country). All Illinois children in kindergarten, second, and sixth grades are required to have an oral health examination by a licensed dentist and to submit proof prior to May 15 of the school year. School dental examinations must be completed within 18 months of the deadline.
- 4. Birth Certificates must be in our office by the first day of school for all kindergarten students and all new students to Graymont Grade School.

To All Graymont Grade School Parents;

For the 2024-25 school year, we request your cooperation in establishing Graymont Grade School as a latex-free district. This year, we will have a student with a severe allergy to products containing latex. These reactions could be life-threatening, and as a district and educational community, we are doing everything we can to help this individual have a healthy school year.

Items that contain latex are balloons, rubber gloves, elastic/rubber bands, spandex, mouse pads, goggles, and potentially lotions and sanitary wipes. The protein in food that can trigger a reaction can be found in avocados, bananas, chestnuts, and kiwis. So, a kiwi-scented wipe can result in a severe allergic reaction requiring a trip to a specialist hospital in Chicago. We ask that any school supplies you purchase for the upcoming year be latex-free, and it is usually annotated on the packaging.

To help with meeting this request, the district will provide pencils and erasers for everyone this coming year, ensuring all students have the necessary supplies without any risk of latex exposure. Balloons are the biggest hazard, and we ask that all celebrations at the school, like a student's birthday, be balloon-free.

Thank you for your assistance in keeping our students safe.

It shall be the policy of the Board of Education of Rooks Creek School District 425 to limit attendance in the District's schools to those students who reside within District boundaries. For the purpose of determining the residency of a pupil, the residence of the person who has legal custody of such pupil shall be presumed to be the residence of the pupil. For the purpose of this policy, "legal custody" means one of the following:

- 1. Custody exercised by a natural or adoptive parent with whom the pupil resides;
- 2. Custody granted by order of a court of competent jurisdiction to a person with whom the pupil resides for reasons other than to have access to the educational programs of the District;
- 3. Custody exercised under a statutory short-term guardianship, provided that within sixty (60) days of the pupil's enrollment a court order is entered that establishes a permanent guardianship and grants custody to a person with whom the pupil resides for reasons other than to have access to the educational programs of the District;
- 4. Custody exercised by an adult caretaker relative who is receiving aid under the Illinois Public Aid Code for the pupil who resides with that adult caretaker relative for purposes other than to have access to the educational programs of the District; or
- 5. Custody exercised by an adult who demonstrates that, in fact, he/she has assumed and exercises responsibility for the pupil and provides the pupil with a regular fixed nighttime abode for purposes other than to have access to the educational programs of the District.

In the event a question concerning the residency of a child arises, The District shall:

- 1. Require the child's parent or guardian to complete a questionnaire in order that the District may determine residency. Such questionnaire shall be routine at the time of original enrollment, and may be required at such other times as the administration deems necessary;
- 2. Conduct an informal investigation to acquire information that may aid the District in determining residency. The administration may require the parent or guardian to submit evidence of residency within the School District, which may include such items as:
- a) Proof of payment of rent or mortgage, such as receipts or cancelled checks;
- b) Utility bills including electricity, water, telephone, and propane/natural gas;
- c) Valid voter's registration card; and
- d) Current Illinois Driver's License or other valid information
- 3. Provide the child and/or the parents or guardians of the child an opportunity to present pertinent information to the District which would aid in determining residency;
- 4. Permit the child and/or the parents or guardians of the child to appeal unfavorable residency determinations to the School Board, provided that the School Board's residency determination after hearing shall be final and binding; and
- 5. Allow the child to attend Rocks Creek School District 425 until the District makes final determination of the child's residency, provided, however, that the child's parents or guardians shall be responsible for payment of the costs (tuition equivalent) incurred by the School District for this interim period of time the child was permitted to attend Rooks Creek School District 425

Any person who knowingly or willfully presents to the District any false information regarding the residency of a pupil for the purpose of enabling the pupil to attend school in the District without the payment of nonresident tuition, or any person who knowingly enrolls or attempts to enroll in the schools of the District on a tuition-free basis, a pupil known by that person to be a nonresident of the District shall be guilty of a Class misdemeanor. Non-resident pupils who attend the school in the District for less than an entire school year shall have their tuition apportioned. Pupils who begin a school year as residents but become non-residents during the school year shall not be charged tuition for the remainder of the school year in which they became non-resident pupils.
