five or more, around up.

For example: 36 would become 40.

If the digit is less than 5, you round down.

For example: 23 would become 20.

Here are more examples.

56 becomes 60

98 becomes 100

14 becomes 10

What about bigger numbers?

Round 154/to the nearest tens.

First, underline the digit in the tens place. 154

Next, look at the digit to the right.

If it is less than 5, the tens digit stays the same and the ones digit becomes a 0.

154 becomes

What if the number was **1782**

Follow the same/rule.


178

The 7 in the tens place becomes an 8. The 8 in the ones place becomes a 0.


50178 becomes 180.

Round to the nearest tens.














Round to the nearest hundreds.
