Junior ROWITA Fellowship Basic Guidelines

Eligibility: Graduating 12th grade women students (public, private or homeschooled) who are United States citizens and St. Johns County residents who have been accepted into an arts based program of higher education.

Intent of Fellowships: To advance the creative endeavors of the applicant. The fellowships are awarded to talented young women artists to further study in their chosen field. Student must be accepted into in a BFA program, summer institute/intensive or workshop. Student must have a 3.0 grade point average.

Fellowship Amount: \$1000 Award

Applications must include:

- Letter of Recommendation from the student's art's area instructor.
 Letter should include a short history of their experience with the applicant.
- Name and address of institution/college/workshop facility that the student will be attending.
- One page essay from the student discussing her arts career goals.
- Audiovisual material and description form for one of the three disciplines:
 Literary, Performance, or Visual Arts. Applicant may apply in only one discipline.

Applications will be scored and rated in the following categories:

- 50 points: Artistic Quality
 Does the student currently evidence a high level of aptitude and skill in their chosen field for their current age?
- 25 points: Capability

Will support for the applicant provide an opportunity for her to continue training in her chosen field? Has the applicant fulfilled all the stated requirements required for the Fellowship?

25 points: Impact

Is the course of study likely to achieve the applicants intended goal(s)?

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Junior ROWITA Fellowship <u>Visual Arts Guidelines</u>

Visual Arts can include architecture, ceramics, drawing, graphic design, painting, printmaking, sculpture, and photography, or mixed media.

Visual Arts applicants should submit a total of 10 images in a digital format.

Visual arts audiovisual must contain:

- Images representing the applicant's work and artistic strengths an demonstrating the artistic range and capabilities of the applicant.
- Artwork completed within the last two years.

Tips:

- Digital images should be saved as JPEG images and oriented correctly for viewing.
- Each image should be saved under a file name in the following format, with the number corresponding to the Image Log: Last Name_Title.jpg
- Images should be a maximum of 1024 x 768 pixel files. File size should be 1000K
 (1MB) maximum. Images that are scanned in should have a resolution of 72 dpi.
- Make sure each image is in focus and well lit.
- Test CD-R to make sure it will open on a different computer.

Ineligible:

- Do not submit hard copy photographs of your work.
- All submissions should be digital images only.
- Do not submit the original artwork.

PERFORMANCE GUIDELINES

Music applicants should include 1 DVD demonstrating her artistic achievement and stage presence. Multiple DVD samples will not be accepted.

- Live solo performances are acceptable. No group scenes or dances. The applicant must be easily identified. DVD should include clear, audible sound.
- DVD should be clearly marked.

Music/Instrumental Audiovisual samples must contain:

- 2 pieces demonstrating the range of artistic ability (up to 4 minutes total).
- If you play several instruments, please select only one for your application.

Music/Theater audiovisual must contain:

- Vocal performance/voice applicants should have musical accompaniment.
- Music Composition applicants should submit 1 2 compositions on paper manuscript and provide a recording of the composition being performed (up to 4 minutes total).
- For *Musical Theater* applicants singing, dancing, and acting monologue (up to 4 minutes total).
- For *Theater* 1 or 2 monologue(s) (up to 4 minutes total).
- The camera must remain stationary but can follow action. The recording must include good sound and lighting while keeping the actor in view at all times.
- The performer may move to accentuate the monologue or song.
- 2 pieces demonstrating the range of artistic ability (up to 4 minutes total).

Dance audiovisual must contain:

- Solo performance only.
- No longer than 4 minutes total.

TIPS:

- Performances should be recorded with a stationary tripod and camera.
- Avoid mirror shots and distracting backgrounds.
- Test DVD to ensure that it will play on a variety of computers.
- DVD should not be filmed from the back of the auditorium in an amateur manner.
