FLORIDA ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENTS

Students must take the following assessments each year and course placement decisions will be determined based on results of the Florida Standards Assessment in ELA (Grades 6-8), Math (Grades 6-8), and the NGSSS State Science Assessment (Grade 8). Students are required to take the End of Course (EOC) exam for Civics in 7th grade and it will be factored in as 30% of their grade. Any student who is in an EOC High School exam course (Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, Algebra 2) must take the EOC.
