- Welcome – Justin Vogel, SAC Co-chair
 - Sign-in Roster
 - Agenda
 - Meeting minutes (Creekside Website, click on “SAC”)
 - SAC funding request (school nurse) - attend health conference in Orlando. Requesting \$696.
 - Voted to fund.
 - SAC funding FBLA – help fund lodging fees for chaperones going to the national conference. 10 students qualified to go. Requesting \$1200.
 - Voted to fund.

- Principal Updates – Mr. Johnson
 - Sprinting to the finish
 - Last week – “Battle of the Classes” – spirit week
 - Students donated 75lbs of care packages to the Betty Griffin House
 - Shining Knights performed at the Pep Rally
 - “Testing Season”
 - HB 7069: Bill to lessen testing after this year, reduces teacher’s VAM from 50% from student data to 1/3, schools will not spend for than 5% (45 hours) on state testing and/or district testing, PERT exam eliminated, 11th grade FSA eliminated, there will no longer be an EOC in every subject
 - Clarification: Is the DDA included under EOCs? Unsure at the moment, but the district will be asked for clarification.
 - There will be **accountability**, but with minimal testing.
