Principal's Update- M. Johnson

- **School Calendar:**
 - 2nd nine weeks awards were last week. We will conduct future awards assemblies in the same "Covid" fashion. This will continue into next school year as well.
 - 2/4 will be ½ day dismissal
 - Steam Night will be 1/25 from 5-7 and will include hands on activities that incorporate literacy week
 - 2/21 No School

 - 4/11-4/14 SAT10 Testing (4 days)
- **School Improvement Title I:**
 - SIP Action Plan review is coming up Feb. 24-mid year goal. There was no additional parent input.
 - Attendance Goal: increase attendance by 2%. We are down from 94% to 90% which can be attributed to COVID
 - Reading Kindergarten Scores Goal: mid year scores increased by 2%. The goal is 3%. Goal should be reached by EOY
 - Insurance funds will be released in February. Should be approximately \$16K with a majority being spent for classrooms.
 - We have a new Title 1 behavior para, Angela Clements. She will be paid w/ Title 1 funds
 - PD for Staff - Bingo Card Opportunities- Staff professional development will be worked into a bingo card. This will allow staff to have some flexibility with scheduling and being able to choose what best fits their needs.
 - New book series adoption for Math - parents and stakeholders are welcome to look over the options.
 - Review of SAC Roster - we will submit the roster to include current members with no changes.
 - Title 1 Survey Results - tabled until April meeting.
