The Collaboration sessions are placed on the course announcement pages to show the student what is available. Students can easily sign up for any session they would like to attend.

^{*}Feedback from students and some teachers regarding the collaborations -

- *Collaboration sessions are also held for the Elementary students.
 - -Students/Parents participate in hands on activities.
 - -Parents have the opportunity to attend Learning Guide support sessions as well.
- *Our Live Lessons have had face-to-face time with teachers (Humanities/STEAM/Music/Spanish/Art and PE)
- *Really enjoy the time with student and parents and getting to know them
- *There will be other live lessons some face to face and some elluminate (Jigsaw) more information to follow regarding these meetings

Lori Wiggins – Multi Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS)

- *Model to match high quality instruction and intervention matched to student needs using data about student learning rates over time and levels of performance.
- *A system that requires team members to approach designing a system to support students by using problem-solving framework

- *Process within the MTSS
 - Step 1 Identify the problem what is the root of the problem gather data
 - Step 2 Why is it occurring analyze the data
 - Step 3 What are we going to do about it matching interventions
 - Step 4 Is it working evaluate the data and collect more data if needed
- *The reason it is called multi tiered support looking at providing support at 3 different levels.
 - Tier 1 general instruction support
 - Tier 2 More support provided
 - Tier 3 The most intensive levels of support
- *MTSS Committee had to be established consists school base leadership members (Faculty, teachers, etc.), but also District Support from various departments.
- *Update the faculty on preliminary MTSS Leadership team discussions.
- *Goal Setting small focus content groups identify topics for additional inquiry as well as some initiatives to consider.
- *Added student services team Guidance Counselor, School Nurse. Social Worker, School Psychologist, Varying Exceptionalities teacher. Assist in developing a system for students needs and problem solve.
- *Designing systems to collect and analyze data for the purpose of problem solving and interventions.
