## Introduction:

Salt dough is so fun! It makes a great art for keepsakes!

If you don't have the ingredients for salt dough, an alternative is playdough (do NOT bake playdough).

## Vocabulary:

*Lines* — is a mark with greater length than width. Lines can be horizontal, vertical, or diagonal; straight or curved; thick or thin.

*Color* — is light reflected off objects. Color has three main characteristics: hue (the name of the color, such as red, green, blue, etc.), value (how light or dark it is), and intensity (how bright or dull it is).

*Pattern* — a combination of elements or shapes repeated in a recurring and regular arrangement

*Form* — are three-dimensional shapes expressing length, width, and depth. Balls, cylinders, boxes, and pyramids are forms.

*3-D* — makes it appear as though some objects are up close while others are farther back.

## **Procedure:**

1<sup>st</sup>: Make your salt dough!

Salt Dough Recipe: Mix the following ingredients. 1/2 Cups of flour 1/4 Cup salt 1/4 Cup water



2<sup>nd</sup>: Roll or sculpt the dough to create a masterpiece. It can be a snake or a rainbow, anything you can think! Your choice. It can even be draped over a bowl to make a little jewelry dish. Don't forget to add textures and impressions.

3<sup>rd</sup>: When your sculpture is finished, bake the dough for 2hrs at 250 degrees.

4<sup>th</sup>: Let your creation cool and then paint!
