HOMEWORK

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION THAT IS PERTINENT REGARDING HOMEWORK IN MY CLASS

Specific "handout" homework is rarely assigned. HOWEVER, the expectation is that a student review their notes for at least 15-30 minutes every day or review the material that was covered during the class period that day. Students are <u>always</u> given a hard copy of the Unit expectations (Unit Scales), the vocabulary, and PowerPoint notes and a Quarter review packet at the beginning of every quarter. In the event your student has lost these papers, everything can be found in the Unit folder on Schoology.

GRADING

Quarter grades will be based on the following percentages

- 70% Tests
- 30% Quizzes, Labs and other assignments

Biology has an End of Course Exam (E.O.C.) will be 30% of the final grade. **<u>REMEDIATION</u>**: If you get less than 85% on a Summative, there will be a chance to re-take it. There are requirements that a student must follow in order to be eligible to retake a Summative. A student can not just retake a test without showing me evidence of understanding the material. In Schoology, there is a check off list of items to do, along with needing a teacher conference prior to retesting. Students will have 48 hours to inquire about remediation and it is their responsibility to check HAC for their grade. They must setup AND keep the retest day and time.

<u>MISSED QUIZZES, TESTS, AND ASSIGNMENTS</u> must be completed as soon as possible. ALL material can be found on Schoology, so a student is able to keep up with their schoolwork. See me after any absence to choose a date and time to make up assessments. If you only missed the day of the test, the next day you return to school you will take the test.
