

SAT – ACT Test Prep



- Standardized tests that evaluate a student's readiness for college work amongst widely different high school curricula.
 - Most colleges require either the SAT or ACT, with no preference for either test.
 - Most students submit scores from both tests.

SAT & ACT Accommodations

If your student has an IEP or 504 Plan, you must give your school counselor signed consent forms for an Accommodation Request for both the SAT and ACT.

You will not automatically receive accommodations unless your school counselor submits a formal request **and** it is approved by the testing agency. The deadlines for submitting a request are typically a full month and a half BEFORE the actual test date.

Super Scoring

Super scoring is the process by which colleges consider your highest section scores **across all the dates you took the SAT or ACT**.

EXAMPLE OF SAT SUPERSCORING

- * 420 on SAT Math
- * 16 on ACT Math

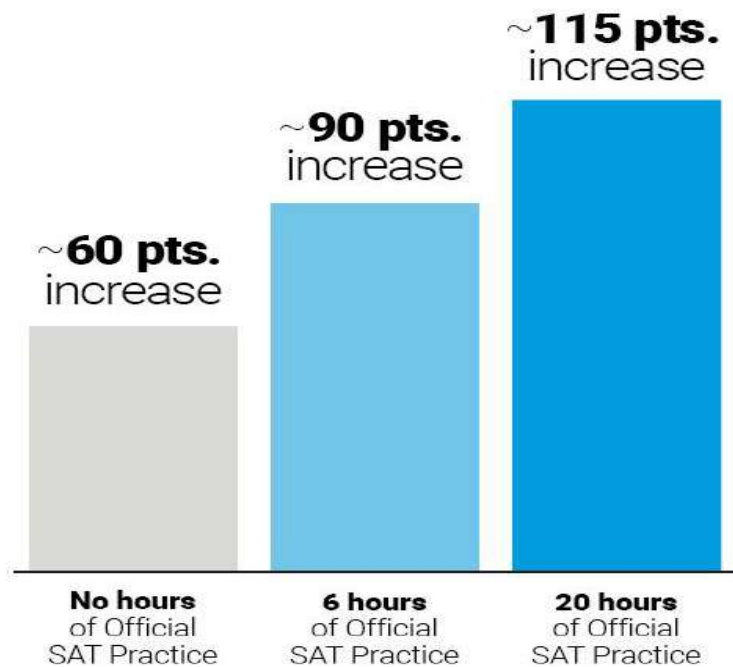

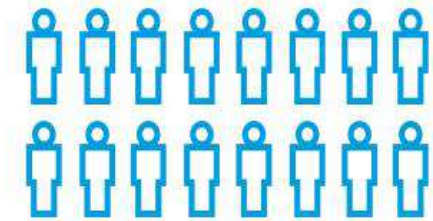

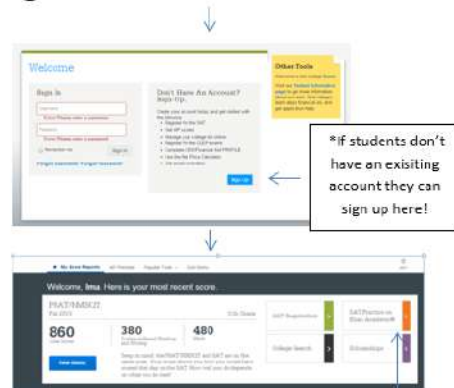

Steps to Linking with Official SAT Practice

- 1: Visit (<https://www.khanacademy.org/sat>)
- 2: Have students click on **Start practicing**
- 3: Students can sign in to Khan Academy using an existing account, Gmail (easiest), Facebook, or create a new account.
- 4: Once logged in, students will have two options to choose from:

A Sign in to CollegeBoard.org and send your test results to Khan Academy. **OR** **B** Take your first diagnostic quiz



*Students can link scores to Khan Academy by clicking SAT Practice.



* Students will be prompted send their scores data



*Students will need to take 4 short quizzes (Math + Reading & Writing) to establish their personalized practice. In addition, there is online dynamic practice with feedback for the optional essay on the ESSAY Tab!
