## HOW THE "OATH PROJECT" WORKS



- The Oath is taken online by any teen, family, or youth group by visiting Facebook.com/SavingOurDaughters or SavingOurDaughters.org. and/or a special community personal visit from Keke Palmer.
- The online Oath is initiated by clicking on an Oath button. After completing a brief form, Oath takers join the list of teens and young adults committed to choosing at least one of the 8 action steps against bullying & suicide in the community.
- Saving Our Daughters will provide a badge or graphic image that community and supporting partners may use as a link to the Oath from their website.
- Schools, organizations, and other groups of 150 or more are asked to have an adult complete Saving Our Daughters' Youth Representative Authorization form to ensure that large groups may be randomly verified.

### GOALS:

501 3-C charity Saving Our Daughters, with Boys & Girls Club of America, and selected schools across the country, have partnered with actress/singer Keke Palmer to deliver a revolutionary level of awareness and action towards bullying and abuse prevention for the teen community across the country.

With such well aligned missions, these partnerships will begin working together on Saving Our Daughters: "The Oath Project" as well as other empowerment related endeavors with underprivileged teens in crisis from bullying in schools and in their community.


