	Fourth-grade reading Hawai'i's average scale score increased by 1 point from 2019 levels. While Hawai'i's year-over-year increase is not statistically significant, it is 3 points higher than the national average for fourth-grade reading, and Hawai'i's performance above the nation is statistically significant.  NAEP results are reported in four achievement levels: below basic, basic, proficient and advanced. The percentage of Hawai'i fourth-graders performing at the proficient and advanced levels in reading increased by 2 points from 2019, and is 3 points higher than the national average.  Over the past decade, while the national average essentially remained unchanged and then declined during the COVID-19 pandemic, Hawai'i's average scale score has shown a significant and steady increase.  Fourth-grade math  In fourth-grade math, Hawai'i's average scale score decreased by 2 points, which is not a statistically significant change.
