|   | <p><b>About the Councils</b></p> <p>School Community Councils (SCCs) play a vital role in Hawai'i's education system. They are part of the leadership structure at each school and enable shared-decision making among principals, teachers, school staff, parents, students and community members to improve student achievement.</p> <p>School Community Councils are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A group of people who are elected by their peers to advise the principal on matters that affect student achievement and school improvement. Their primary role is to participate in the process that ensures that the needs of all students are addressed in the school's Academic Plan.</li> <li>• Forums for open discussion and problem-solving related to student achievement. Research suggests that the collaborative process contributes to improved school culture, classroom practices and student learning, and the development of a strong professional community of educators.</li> <li>• A means to involve the community in the discussion of educational issues and help schools identify and respond to the educational needs of the community.</li> </ul> |
|   | <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Purpose of SCC - School Community Council</b></p> <p><b>As Stated in the Handbook</b><br/> As described in Act 51, School Community Councils were established "to provide a mechanism whereby parents, the community and other key stakeholders can have a substantially increased voice in the affairs of their local schools, with a clear and concrete enunciation of powers and responsibilities, and how these are shared with those of the principal."</p>   |
