Administration Report - Deena Moraes

- General School updates
 - o Hired a new part time custodian
 - o Hired a new RTI instructor, can now provide RTI for 5th, 6th, & Kinder
 - o Choose Love program is going well, teachers appreciating the PLC meeting times
 - o Choose Love: 2/2 Pep Rally for students at a morning assembly led by Scarlett Lewis. She will come back in the evening for a parent night (5-6pm). PTA to provide free pizza. Feb 3 Choose Love presentation for the teachers.
 - o POSITIONS FOR NEXT YEAR:
 - Projected 190 students, PTA & HSF covering one line each for a teaching position. Deena will accept geographical exemptions for every grade except 4th.
 - WSF Granted 2 more positions.
 - 1 Sped (probably not happening in future years)
 - Academic Coach/RTI this is a two part position .5 RTI, .5 Academic Coach could be one or two hires. Hopeful to retain this position for a few years.
 - In a good position financially for next year. ESSER Drop to cover iReady (about \$16,000) and Tier 1,2,3 resources/consumables. (Kerrin would like to know if some of that earmarked money can be reallocated to Barton)
 - Going to meet with ART team Jan 27, then propose budget to faculty at meeting, then to SCC for review.

iReady Data

- o Amazing growth already. In reading, 78% of students have already made typical growth for the year. Went from 31% On-Grade Level or Above in August to 65% at the half year point.
- o Math 85% of students have already made their typical growth for the year. 28% of students in August were On-Grade Level or Above, this is now at 71%.
- o Teachers are in the process of adjusting their student groups and setting more goals.
- Waiver Day review and request of signature
 - o No need to request additional days off.
 - o School to implement Carnegie Learning and "Write Reflections" programs next year. These trainings will take place on already scheduled Teacher Days.

PTA and HSF Reports:

- PTA Report- Had a great end of year with merchandise sales, looking to the next 2 big fundraisers, Fitness Challenge in February and Hanalei School Golf Tournament at Makai Club in April.
- Hanalei School Foundation (HSF) Report Craft night went very well, good parent and student turn out. Give Big Aloha fundraiser earned much less than in years' past, but still took in \$3-4k.
