<u>Administration Report</u> - Tony Sines

- Academic & Financial Plan: Academic Draft Plan summary presented potential new math curriculum being discussed island wide, showed Faculty Input Process. Financial Plan 2021-2022 projected student enrollment is 221 kids, budget is \$1,432,555, 2 teachers to be paid for by PTA for \$130k which balances the budget (current enrollment is 248)
- Quarter 4 Return to Learn Plan Department of Transportation just announced the road will open starting on Saturday with a convoy schedule that will reflect school drop off and pick up times. School will open on Monday and follow A/B schedule until April 5th when full in person instruction starts

 - Does the DOT have any information on the stability of the upper hillside and how additional heavy rains can effect that? – please contact DOT directly
 - O Is the plan to use the school bus to get kids to school from Princeville? 178 kids on Princeville side so more buses would be needed, COVID guidance needed on how many kids can sit on a seat, can't force parents to send their kids on the bus, parents can sign up for the bus online using student's ID number, could poll parents on who would send their children on the bus
 - Any weight concerns from DOT on full buses? no
 - How will school service children with IEPs virtually? depends on the individual child and situation
 - Concerns on the number of cars at pick up time when school goes back full time potential for staggered release times
 - Is there a back up plan to get children out of Hanalei in case of future problems? we will be extra cautious on when to cancel school and not take chances
