- Student Council Report Michaela Meuldijk
  - o No student council report; student not present
- PTA Report Korin
  - o We need a Treasurer and other board members (VP not required)
    - an email has gone out; more communication to parents to come
    - without PTA, there will be no enrichment for students and no PLCs for staff

## Administration Report (30 Minutes): Tony Sines

- Hanalei School Playground Project
  - o state of current playground: rusting, rotting, etc.- potential liability
    - temporary fixes
  - o Tony & Sonja met with Peter Tammetta from Highwire
    - Kompan -Denmark company
      - no powder coating, etc. made differently than current equipment
      - supervision will be easier with design of equipment
      - monkey bars, swings, teeter totter, climbing wall, etc.
      - More capacity; won't seem as crowded

- Costs: Total Estimate \$175k --- DOE said they would match half w/ a deadline of June 2019, but now we are looking for a donor or raise money...
  - o structure: \$68k
  - o deliver & install: \$85-90k
  - safety surfacing: might be \$70k
  - o removal of structure: roughly \$15k
- Next Steps:
  - work with Monica Barton from DOE
  - establish timeline
  - raise money- how???
- Professional Development
  - 40 Developmental Assets
    - youth with more assets (external & internal) are more likely to do well in school and least likely to engage in high-risk behaviors (drugs, alcohol, etc.) or be victims of abuse, etc.
    - Kauai longitudinal study looked at kids born around 1955 and followed them for 40-60 years to look at struggles & assets or protective factors that helped them be successful or not
    - Reinforces the power of educators on kids, regardless of their home/family assets & that educators can positively affect generations of students (potentially)
    - What can we do as a building to build assets???
      - ideas for how to support, youth groups...
      - S.O.S. Save One Student
        - staff members sign-up to be involved in that child's life (beyond classroom teacher) as "mentors"
          - spending time, eating lunch, positive interactions

#### New Business (10 min)

- Recruiting SCC membership for next year ASAP
  - o reps from different groups: 8-10 people ideally
    - teachers (certs) & classified/casual (non-certs), parents, community, student reps
- Projection for next year: 249 kids
  - o One .5 position open
  - o waiting for science grant
  - o .5 position may be used for Paulette Adams' position
  - o need 2 sixth grade teachers

- o two small 3rd will be combined into one 4th for next year
- o one 4th grade teacher will move to 6th grade
- o losing a SpEd teacher and EA
