

## How-To Create Your Schedule Class of 2024

Traditionally, this information would be shared with you multiple times in person before we came to this point of the process, but as you all know we are not in a traditional time. You are starting your high school career in a form and fashion no one has experienced before. Below you will find simple instructions on how to create your class schedule for your freshman year. Do not let this be overwhelming. The process itself is pretty easy once you make just a few simple decisions.

### Things to know:

- You do not have to take four-years of Spanish or a foreign language to be accepted into a college. There are certain degree and career paths which will be easier to complete in the future if you have four-years of foreign language.
- You are required to take English, Math, Freshman Rotation, and PE or Band as a Freshman. If you are a band student, you do not need to take a PE class. Freshman Rotation is a class the High School office will schedule for you based on your birthday. You will not schedule a 3<sup>rd</sup> Hour Class.
- No students will schedule a Weights and Fitness class, this class will be put together by taking interested students to the weight room out of PE class. You will simply register for a PE class.
- The schedule you see has a lot of classes blacked out. This was done so it would be easier for you to make your choices, because the classes which are blacked out you are not able to take as a freshman.

### Scheduling Process:

- Choose your elective and place it in first, second, fourth, or fifth hour – depending where it falls on the schedule. It is recommended this be Biology I, World History, Geography, or Spanish I. Remember fifth hour is remote. \*\*If you are a band student, place band in first hour then choose an elective to be put in second, fourth, or fifth hour.
- Next, choose your math class. Those of you who successfully completed Algebra in 8<sup>th</sup> grade should be ready for Geometry (Robinson/Visintin), those of you who didn't should look at Algebra I with Mrs. Noller.
- You should fill the final two hours available with English (Murphy) and/or PE if you are not a band student. Band Students will just complete their schedule by adding English, since PE is not required.
