

How-To Create Your Schedule Class of 2022

Traditionally, this information would be shared with you multiple times in person before we came to this point of the process, but as you all know we are not in a traditional time. Below you will find simple instructions on how to create your class schedule. This will be a very similar process to what you have completed in the past, just with fewer classes and options. Do not let this be overwhelming. The process itself is pretty easy once you make just a few simple decisions.

Things to know:

- If you are in Band you do not have to take PE, and it is recommended band members use this opportunity to take an additional academic class.
- As a Junior you may opt out of PE class – which is currently being recommended to allow students to have access to more academic classes.
- You must take US History or AP US History as a Junior.
- If you do not yet have at least 2 science credits, you must take a science.

Scheduling Process:

- Enter any class that is a singleton (only offered once in a day) first and put that in your schedule.
- Next enter your Math.
- Third choose your science if needed.
- Next enter your US History choice.
- Lastly, enter in English (if not enrolling in Honors English III) and/or P.E. if you choose to not take advantage of the academic waiver.

YOUR SCHOOL DAY WILL RUN FROM 8:15 AM TO 11:27 AM. BUSES WILL NOT RUN UNTIL NOON AFTER DISMISSAL. IF YOU SIGNED UP FOR A LUNCH, YOU WILL HEAD TO THE CAFETERIA TO GRAB IT AND THEN LEAVE. OTHERWISE, YOU ARE FREE TO GO AT 11:27 PM. WATER BOTTLES WILL BE ALLOWED, AS WATER FOUNTAINS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE.

*IF YOU PLAN TO ATTEND CACC, YOU WILL BE ALLOWED TO START YOUR DAY 2ND HOUR. YOU WILL TAKE ONLY YOUR REQUIRED GRADUATION COURSES AND THEN HEAD TO CACC IN THE AFTERNOON. ASSUMING YOU ARE CURRENTLY ON TRACK FOR GRADUATION, YOU WOULD NEED TO TAKE ENGLISH III, MATH, AND US HISTORY. THE BUS FOR CACC WILL LEAVE AT 12:15 PM FROM THE PARKING LOT OUTSIDE THE CAFETERIA. YOU WILL GRAB YOUR LUNCH FROM THE CAFETERIA AND GET ON THE BUS. YOU MAY ALSO DRIVE YOURSELF IF YOU FILL OUT A LIABILITY WAIVER AND HAVE YOUR PARENTS SIGN OFF ON IT. YOU CAN GET ONE OF THOSE FROM THE OFFICE.
