How-To Create Your Schedule Class of 2023

Traditionally, this information would be shared with you multiple times in person before we came to this point of the process, but as you all know we are not in a traditional time. Below you will find simple instructions on how to create your class schedule. This will be a very similar process to what you have completed in the past, just with fewer classes and options. Do not let this be overwhelming. The process itself is pretty easy once you make just a few simple decisions.

Things to know:

Scheduling Process:

- Enter any class that is a singleton (only offered once in a day) first and put that in your schedule.
- Next enter your Math.
- Third choose your science and/or history class.
- Lastly, enter in English and P.E.
