Steps for Changing Account:

- 1. Login into your FLVS account
- 2. Click the Virtual School Administrator link to enter VSA.
- Click the menu (3 lines) at the top left of the screen next to FLVS.
- 4. Click Student Records then Academic Profile.
- Click the dropdown to the right of the Physical School and select the new school.
- 6. Scroll to the bottom right and click SAVE.
