The right time to take the test:

- Junior year is the best time for most students
- SAT or ACT is given almost every month
- Many students take the SAT / ACT more than once
- College apps are due fall / winter of senior year

Which test to take? When do I take it?

- All **Sophomores** are registered for the **PSAT** automatically. **Freshman** and **Juniors** may consider taking it for additional practice. **Juniors** are also encouraged to take the PSAT for National Merit Consideration. [National Merit Homepage](#)
- **Juniors** should take BOTH the **SAT & ACT** in the **late Fall or Winter** seasons. Once students know their "preferred" test, we encourage them to continue testing until they reach their desired score. **The goal is to have a "college application ready" score by the beginning of senior year.**
- Students interested in participating in **Dual Enrollment** may consider testing early. Students wanting to participate in DE as Juniors will need a qualifying test score in the early spring of Sophomore year.



Community Service Updates!

FREE TEST PREP RESOURCES:
