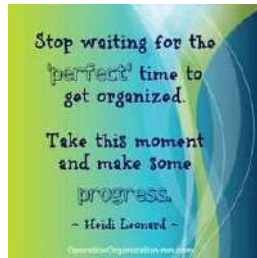

- **Write everything down!** Don't expect yourself to remember everything that you have to do. Whether you are using a phone app, planner, or notebooks- have a consistent way of keeping track of your to-do list.
- **Use tools to stay organized:** Use a multi-pocketed backpack, pencil pouch, folders, and notebooks to keep like things together and different things separate. Keep papers for the same class together and have different folders for each course.
- **Color code and label everything:** This will give you visual cues of your system and help you remember where everything goes.
- **Break big tasks into smaller ones:** This will help the tasks seem less overwhelming and if you assign deadlines to the smaller tasks, then the deadline will be manageable.
- **Establish a nighttime routine:** Set aside time each night to make sure you are ready for the next day. You can lay out your clothes, confirm that homework is completed and in your backpack, etc.
