Our Goals for Student Achievement

District Smart Goals (CCPS) 2021-2022:

Strategic Improvement Plan Performance Objectives:

Objective 1: By 2023, Clayton County Public Schools will increase the percentage of students scoring at the Proficient and/or Distinguished levels on the Georgia Milestones to at least 80% in each content area.

Mt. Zion Primary Goals:

By May 2022, K-2 grade students at Mt. Zion Primary will increase their reading skills by 25% and math skills by 15%. *Our focus in <u>reading</u> will be phonics, fluency and comprehension.*Our focus in <u>math</u> will be understanding whole number values, place value and grouping in ten and ones. Students will have shown the improvement based on I-Ready scores, and Benchmark scores to name a few.

In The Kindergarten Classroom and Virtual Learners

The kindergarten team will work with students and their families to support students' success in the *Common Core Standards* for Reading and Math.

Some of our key connections with families will be:

- Help students learn and remember sounds and sight words. Teachers will send sight words home for students to practice.
- Have students decorate flash cards to practice counting skills 1-100. Flash cards can be used at home to practice with parents.
- Develop goals and strategies that can be used in the classroom and at home to increase phonics.
 Consistent communication with parents about child's progress.



In The First Grade Classroom:

The 1st grade team will work with students and their families to support students' success in the Common Core Standards for Reading and Math.

Some of our key connections with families will be:

- Develop weekly goals with students that focus on increasing their phonics and comprehension skills. Goals will be sent home to parents so that skills may be practiced at home.
- Develop the same weekly goals with students in math that focus on increasing their skill in fractions, place value, and measurement. Teachers will give a weekly assignment that students can use to study at home with parents.

In The 2nd Grade Classroom:

The 2nd grade team will work with students and their families to support students' success in the *Common Core Standards* for Reading and Math.

Some of our key connections with families will be:

- Teachers will help students create flashcards to use in the classroom and at home as a connection resource in order to prepare for unit quizzes and tests.
- Weekly reading assignments with discussion questions will be used as study guides to help with fostering comprehension.
- Math fact Strategies will be practiced at home so that students may continue to increase their skills with counting, grouping and place value.

At Home

Mt. Zion Primary parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support students' success in Reading, Writing, and Math.

Kindergarten:

Some of our key at-home activities will be:

- Parents will practice sight words with students at home.
- Use flash cards to practice counting with child and putting numbers in order from 1-100.
- Use suggested teacher strategies to support my child's learning with phonics.

First Grade:

Some of our key at-home activities will be:

- Use weekly goals given in the classroom to support child's learning at home. Building comprehension skills and phonics will be displayed through activities such as story time and family interaction.
- Math goals will be supported at home by studying the weekly assignment and using as a tool for discussion and learning.

2nd Grade:

Some of our key at-home activities will be:

- Students will use flashcards to practice and prepare for all tests and quizzes at the end of each math and reading unit.
- Reading assignments will be completed at home and reading logs will be used to measure and track student's participation with phonic skills and comprehension. Logs will be signed by the parent and returned to the teacher weekly.
- Math facts will be used as a study support at home with parents to help students develop and increase their math skills.

2nd Grade Goals for Home

- I will use my flashcards every day to study and help me prepare for my tests.
- Use my reading assignments to discuss my story with my parent and create my own "reading wall" at home. I will use these words to make up my own story and share it with my teacher and my class.
- My math facts will help me with counting money and using numbers in places like the bank and the grocery store. I canalso use math facts to create games using numbers.
